I, Moti Lal Gupta, s/o Late Ramanand Gupta, aged about 61 years, resident of Moti Bhawan, Nehru Road, Siliguri, would like to report an incident of theft that occurred at my residence on the afternoon of 23rd of August, 2022.

The theft took place in the rear portion of the first floor of my residence. The thieves ransacked the rooms and took away many articles of our daily use as well other items of value. Among the other things that were stolen, were electrical wires, electric switches, clothes, two unused cylinders of LPG for domestic use issued by Indian Oil Distributor Chiraag, and other household items. The date of the tax invoices for the LPG cylinders issued by the distributor were 13-08-2022 and 18-08-2022 booked for consumer ID 12228/7500000005074054.
