Respected Sir/Madam,

I, SMT. ILA MANDAL, W/o Late Haricharan Mandal, resident of Naukaghat, Ward No. 31, Shaktigarh, Siliguri in the District of Jalpaiguri - 734005, would like to lodge a complaint stating as follows:

That on 05.06.2018, my husband expired and at present, I am the only person staying in the said house and I am also getting aged, at present aged about 60 years dependent upon the pension of my husband and some gold jewelry left by him for me.

That since last few years my in-laws, namely, (1) Sri Amar Mandal, (2) Sri Samar Mandal, both are S/o Late Naresh Mandal, i.e. my brother-in-laws and sister-in-law (3) Smt. Jayanti Das, W/o Late Khokhan Das, D/o Late Naresh Mandal, have been desperately trying to oust me from my house and for that they have been using various tactics.

It is to be mentioned that one probate case is pending before the Ld. District Judge at Jalpaiguri vide O.C. Probate Case No. 1 of 18 as one "WILL" has been left by my father-in-law giving the entire land in favour of my husband thus the abovenamed persons are continuously forcing me to withdraw the case even threatened to kill me or to face dire consequences and on earlier occasions various complaints have been lodged also case under section 144 Cr.P.C. have been filed due to their continuous illegal activities but nothing could stop them.

That today, i.e. on 08.09.2022, I left my house at morning at about 11 a.m. and around 7 p.m. when I came back to my house I was horrified to see that the abovenamed persons along with their family members namely (1) ARCHANA MANDAL, W/o Amar Mandal, (2) TATAI MANDAL, (3) PAPAI MANDAL both are son of Amar Mandal, (4) NAMITA MANDAL, W/o Samar Mandal, (5) BABU MANDAL, (6) CHHOTKA MANDAL S/o Samar Mandal & (8) SUBOJIT MANDAL S/o Samar Mandal, all are residents of Naukaghat, Ward No. 31, Saktigarh, Dist - Jalpaiguri, broke down the backside door of my house and stolen away 30-35 Bhoris of Gold and Rs.20,000/- cash that was kept there in almirah.

It is to be mentioned here that the above named persons resides at the back side of my house and on earlier occasions also they have tried on several occasions to break the backside door of my house but never succeeded in my presence.

4. Sir, I am a senior citizen and helpless widow residing alone in the said house and barely living with the little pension amount of my deceased husband and today after this incident I fall down in a very devastative situation and I am also in fear that after this act they even kill me at any night.

You are, therefore, requested to treat the present complaint as F.I.R. and take necessary action to recover my stolen jewelry and cash.
