Sir,
With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Shyamal Das (35) S/O Lt. Bachha Das of Bhaktinagar, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

1. 08 (Eight) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml.)
2. 07 (Seven) bottles of Himalayan Fata Fati 70 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 300 ml)

I, PSI-Pradeep Diwali presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 10.09.2022 at 19.35 hrs I received a secret source information that one person namely Shyamal Das (35) S/O Lt. Bachha Das of Bhaktinagar, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling ID liquor illegally at his shop at NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar area, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General diary vide NJP PS GDE No. 487 dated 10.09.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with CV/306 Biswajit Roy and CV/824 Niru Kumar Yadav all of NJP PS, SPC left for NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to work out the information in hand. At about 19.55 hrs hrs we arrived at NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar, and being identified by the source I held raid at the shop of the said accused and managed to apprehend him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is selling ID liquor at his shop since long for his illegal gain. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his shop. On demand he failed to produce any documents/licence in respect of store/sale the I/D liquor recovered from his shop. Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure list and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 20.15 hrs to 20.45 hrs

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your kind honour that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused namely Shyamal Das (35) S/O Lt. Bachha Das of Bhaktinagar, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
