With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Dilip Sarkar (46) s/o Lt. Niranjan Sarkar of Suryasen Colony, Ward No.- 34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

1. 08 (Eight) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml.)
2. 06 (Six) bottles of bottles of Kingfisher Strong Premium Beer each bottle containing 650 ML

1. PSI-Pradeep Diyali presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 20.09.2022 at 22.15 hrs I received a secret source information that one person namely Dilip Sarkar (46) s/o Lt. Niranjan Sarkar of Suryasen Colony, Ward No.- 34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling I/D liquor illegally at his shop at 70 More, near Basundhara Abasan, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General diary vide NJP PS GDE No. 997 dated 20.09.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with VP/08 Laxman Roy, CV/116 Rohit Kumar Mahat, HG 794 Ranjit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for 70 More, near Basundhara Abasan, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to work out the information in hand. At about 22.45 hrs we arrived at NJP Bhaktinagar Bazar, and being identified by the source I held raid at the shop of the said accused and managed to apprehend him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is selling I/D liquor at his shop since long for his illegal gain. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his shop. On demand he failed to produce any documents, licence in respect of store/sale the I/D liquor recovered from his shop. Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure list and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 2255 hrs to 2315 hrs.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your kind honour that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused namely Dilip Sarkar (46) s/o Lt. Niranjan Sarkar of Suryasen Colony, Ward No.- 34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
