I SI Srimanta Chatterjee S/o Lt Debi Prasad Chatterjee of Bhaktinagar Police Station, under Siliguri Police Commissionerate after producing one arrested accused person namely Sanju Das-32yrs s/o Lt Ananda Das of Dasarathpally ward No-44 of SMC PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri along with seizure articles (1) 50 (Fifty) Vials of DIAZEPAM INJECTION each vial containing 02 ML (2) 50 (Fifty) Vials of PHENERGAN INJECTION each vial containing 02 ML (3) 50 (Fifty) Vials LUPIGESIC INJECTION each vial containing 02 ML contained in a paper cartoon do hereby lodged written complaint to the effect that on 02.10.22 at 17:05 hrs received reliable source information that one person has gathered huge Prohibited injections in his house at Dasarathpally under Bhaktinagar PS to deliver the same to someone. It is reasonably believe that the person possessing the Injection may escape from the scene if Police party did not reach the spot immediately. The information was reduced in writing vide Bhaktinagar Police Station GDE no. 77 dated 02.10.22 and informed superiors about the plan of action. Thereafter myself along with SI Sajal Roy, ASI Dipak Karmakar, C/1430 Dilip Barman, CVF/935 Bipllab Roy, CVF/014 Labonomoy Barman taking blank paper, wax, metal seal and knife and other investigation kits left for Dasarathpally to work out the information vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No-78 dated 02.10.22 & MCC No1397/22 dated 02.10.22.

At 17:45 hours I along with officer and force reached at Dasarathpally and contacted the source who show us the house of that person from a certain distance, I briefed all Officers and force to cordon the persons as tactful as possible in order to thwart his escape from the scene. Meanwhile I called two independent witnesses namely 1) Biswajit Saha-31yrs s/o Ratan Saha of Dasarathpally, ward no-44 PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and (2) Prakash Paul-26yrs s/o Lt Haripada Paul of Dasarathpally, ward no-44 PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri after apprising them about the information received requested them in written to remain present with us during search and seizure and also called one Videographer namely Subho Roy S/O Samir Roy of Dasarathpally, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri with a request to record the whole process. We rounded him up and questioned about his name and address when he disclosed his identity as above. On interrogation about the drugs, initially did not disclose anything about this. I forced him to open it, when he disclosed that the bag contains injections belong to him. On further interrogation he disclosed that he procured the illegal injections from one Biki Balmiki of Dasarathpally, near TB Hospital PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri to deliver the same to another person. Then I detained him and gave an option in writing whether he is willing to be searched in presence of an Executive Magistrate or Gazette Police Officer, on return he given written reply that he is willing to be searched in presence of Executive Magistrate. Then I informed Sri Maksedur Rahaman, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Investigation unit) SPC as Special Executive Magistrate to come at Dasarathpally, requested him to presence during search and seizure of the injections.

At 20:05 hrs Maksudur Rahaman, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Investigation unit) SPC arrived at spot. Thereafter I opened the paper cartoon and found illegal injections inside. I asked the accused person above named to produce document if any in support of possessing such a huge quantity of injections with him but he failed to produce any document. I seized the following articles under proper seizure list in presence of witness under direct supervision of Sri Maksudur Rahaman, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Investigation unit) SPC under proper labeling.

NATURE OF ARTICLES SEIZED

- 1) 50 (Fifty) Vials LUPIGESIC INJECTION composition with Buprenorphine hydrochloride-1P equivalent to Buprenorphine 0.3Mg each vial containing 02 ML (Total-100ML) marked as **Exhibit-A** out of 02 vials taken as sample marked as **Exhibit-A1**
- 2) 50 (Fifty) Vials of PHENERGAN INJECTION which composition with hydrochloride-1P 25mg, each vial containing 02 ML (Total-100ML) marked as **Exhibit-B** out of 02 vials taken as sample marked as **Exhibit-B-1**
- 3) 50 (Fifty) Vials of DIAZEPAM INJECTION composition with Diazepam 1P 5 mg, each vial containing 02 ML (Total-100ML) marked as **Exhibit-C** out of 02 vials taken as sample marked as **Exhibit-C-1** (Sl no-1, 2 & 3 total-300grams)


(Seizure was made in between on 02.10.22 in between 20:15 hrs to 21:15 hrs)

Under the above circumstances it is evident that the accused person above named procured has committing offence under NDPS act. On interrogation accused person confessed his guilt and stated that he was doing such kind of business illegally with any valid documents/License since long for his wrongful gain. It is crystal clear that the accused person is peddling prescription drugs meant for the sick people to cater to the need of drugs abusers in the locality illegally which has become menace to the life of the young generation and perishing the home of thousand parents. All the seized contents Psychotropic substance and falls under NDPS act. I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C. after explaining him about the ground of arrest issuing proper meme of arrest. Arrested accused person along with seized articles brought to PS, seizure list and seized articles handed over to Malkhana dealing Officer under intimation to I.C. PS for keeping record in PS property register.

I therefore pray that a specific case u/s Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 may kindly be started against the accused persons namely Sanju Das-32yrs s/o Lt Ananda Das of Dasarathpally ward No-44 of SMC PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and Biki Balmiki of Dasarathpally, Near TB hospital ward No-44 PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri also arrange for its investigation.
