In producing herewith one accused person namely Subal Das (54) S/O Lt. Sanaram Das of Purba Sipahipara, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and following seized articles under seizure -

1. 02 (two) Bundle of Rhino Top 10 Chocolate bomb each bundle containing five Packets, total 10 packets (each packet containing 12 pieces) i.e $10 \times 12 = 120$ Pieces.
 2. 06 (Six) Bundle of Rhino Power Chocolate bomb each bundle containing five Packets, total 30 packets (each packet containing 12 pieces) i.e $30 \times 12 = 360$ Pieces.
 3. 20 (twenty) Packets of Deepars Electric Sparklers (each packet containing 10 pieces) i.e $20 \times 10 = 200$ pieces.
 4. 02 (two) Bundle of King Cobra Fire Crackers each packets containing 50 pieces i.e $02 \times 50 = 100$ Pieces
 5. 05 (five) packets of Sastha Twinkling Star each containing 05 packets, total 25 pieces i.e $25 \times 10 = 250$ pieces
- 02 (two) packets of super flower pots , each containing 05 pieces.

Total Weight: 11.900 Kg of Fire Crackers including its Packets.

I, ASI- Sajal Das of New Jalpaiguri Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodged this written complaint against the above mentioned accused person namely Subal Das (54) S/O Lt. Sanaram Das of Purba Sipahipara, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to the effect that today on 22.10.2022 at 18.45 hrs received a secret information that one Subal Das has stored huge quantity of Fire-crackers at his shop at Bhalobasa More area for selling the same in the open market for his wrongful gain without having any license or other valid documents in respect of the same, violating the provision of law which may endanger human life and likely to cause injury of human life. This refers to NJP PS GDE No 1019 dated 22.10.2022 . Accordingly, as per your kind order I along with SI Newton Biswas, VP/13 Jamirul Islam, CV/306 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC rushed to the spot to work out the information.

On reaching at Bhalobasa More area, I contacted with my source and being identified by the source apprehended one person with the above mentioned seized articles (Fire crackers) being stored in his shop at Bhalobasa More area under New Jalpaiguri PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate . On interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above,
