With benign submission I, SI. Diptajit Dhar presently Posted to Siliguri PS under your kind disposal do hereby lodge this written complaint against 30 to 35 unknown devotees of Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat under Siliguri PS area to the effect that on 30.10.2022 at 16.05 hrs while I am performing Special Chatt Puja mobile patrolling van duty at Airview More area Vide Siliguru PS MCC No. 1951/22 Date. 30/10/2022 that time received an information that some of the devotees went to the nearby island at Mahananda river of Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat Airview More.

On arrival at Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat found that more that 30 to 35 persons offering their puja at the nearby island of Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat by gathering sand and river bed materials, obstructing the free flow of water of the river Mahanda and also offering flower, fruits and garlands and banyan trees which violating of the respective order of National Green tribunal. In this regard announcement had made and campaigning had done for several days at the Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat area and also at that time myself started announcement through the public address system attached to our vehicle regarding the guidelines of honorable green tribunal and directed them to vacant the sand bank situated at the Mahananda river but they pay no heed to the announcement, the persons who were in the middle of the Mahananda River bed surrounded by water where it was very much difficult to reach them and they took privilege of the location and omitting the announcement and direction of National Green Tribunal and also pay no heed to the direction of Police.

After announcement through the public address system myself along with force took preparation to go to the river bed and to stop the illegal act done by the said unknown devotees of the said locality, seeing our preparation they escaped from the sand bank situated middle of the river to the opposite bank of the Mahananda river along with the all worshipping articles by vacant the island.

I therefore pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against 30 to 35 unknown devotees of Lal Mohan Moulik Ghat under Siliguri PS area for gathering sand and river bed materials for Puja by obstructing the free flow of water of the river Mahanda and also offering flower, fruits and garlands and banyan trees which causes pollution of river and violating of the respective order of National Green tribunal, under proper sections of law and to arrange for its investigation.
