would like to inform you that I am one of the
partner of Apex diagnostic and polyclinic along
with Mr. Jayanta Shor, Dr. C.P. Sharma and Mrs
Sharma. Since couple of days dispute is going on
between me, Mr. Jayanta Shor, and between
Dr. C.P. Sharma and his wife Mrs Mrs Sharma
over the issue of management affairs of said
Apex diagnostic & polyclinic. After going through the
Record it appears that Dr. C.P. Sharma in collusion
with his wife Mrs Mrs Sharma have criminally
misappropriated a huge sum by taking and issuing
money receipt in his own name from the patient
using the machinery of the said institution.
When I asked about the same, Dr. C.P. Sharma
threatened me with dire consequences if I raise
any voice and obstructs the work with other
partner. In this regard I would like to mention
that on 6/11/2022 I took one machinery part-
from my said institution for repairment and

polyclinic we have been accused of committing
theft of our own machinery by our own
employee. It is our firm belief that Dr. C.D.
Sharma in order to get rid of his own criminal
liability made a deep rooted conspiracy with
other employee of Apex diagnostic & polyclinic
to frame us with false criminal accusation.

Hence we shall be highly obliged if you
would take necessary legal steps in this
regard and do the needful accordingly.
