Sir,

This is to bring to your due notice that during raid and monitoring on a secret tip off on 08.11.2022 01:00am, I along with my officers and staff had been to DG14 compartment under Dabgram Range and Baikunthapur Division and found one person coming out of DG 14 compartment with a single barreled gun in hand. We followed him upto the house of Krishna Kumar Chhetri S/o Nor Bahadur Chhetri. We knocked at the door several times and a person opened the gate. We disclosed our identity to him. After informing him that we want to search his house, we entered the house and searched thoroughly. We found the one single barreled gun, an empty cartridge, a live peacock concealed in a jute bag, one tortoise carapace, a turtle carapace, a bow and arrow etc. The person disclosed his identity as Krishna Kumar Chhetri S/o Nor Bahadur Chhetri, resident of Bottlevita, Nepali Busty, Post office: Sahudangihat, District Jalpaiguri. On being asked for such possession of arms, he could not produce any legal authority in support of such possession of arms. In his residence we found a live peacock concealed in thin jute bag and could not satisfy us regarding such possession of live peacock.

Accordingly I seized the Arms (the single barreled Gun) and an empty cartridge along with the live peacock and few other things relevant for the purpose duly described in the said seizure list.

As possession of illegal arms and ammunition violates Indian Arms Act, 1959, appropriate prosecution needs to be initiated under the said Act after registering specific case under due section of the laws against the said person.

The accused has already been forwarded before the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate this under Section 9 and section 51 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and he is in judicial custody, P.O.R Case no 32/DG of 2022-23 dated 08.11.2022.
