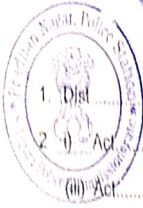

With due respect I Smt. Pushpita Majumdar, D/o Shri Manik Majumdar, resident of Pati Colony, Road No-3, P.O. & P.S. Pradhan Nagar, Dist- Darjeeling, would like to draw your kind attention to the following effect that I am the registered owner of the vehicle (Tata Sumo VICTE DI CX EII) being No- WB 76 A 3623 and my said Vehicle was used to drive by aforesaid Narayan Das and said Narayan Das in the month of May, 2021 my aforesaid Vehicle was sold-out as scrap in several garages in piecemeal manner for which aforesaid person asked apologized before me and made a promised to pay Rs-2,25,000/- by January 2022 and also entered into an agreement for sale, the aforesaid agreement is also annexed with this complaint. And according to that agreement on 26/06/2022 he also issued one cheque of U.C.O Bank being No- 000053 in the name of me of Rs- 50,000/- and I deposited the same with my banker i.e., Union Bank, Pati Colony Branch, but the said cheque was returned by his banker as insufficient fund for which I immediately contacted with aforesaid Narayan Das, then he requested me not to proceed the same by the Court of Law or Police and very shortly he will pay my entire amount and again on 31/08/2022 he issued another cheque being No-000055 of U.C.O. Bank in the name of me of Rs- 25,000/- but said cheque was also dishonored as fund in-sufficient. Thereafter I several time contacted with aforesaid person but he did not responded by any means on the other hand he threatened me by saying that I have nothing to do against him. The aforesaid person purposefully with held my bonafied claimed for his illegal gain and tried to cheat me for his illegal gain intentionally. Some intentional delay was occurred to lodge this complaint due to the illness of my mother. I am single mother woman and in a very helpless condition I approach before you to take appropriate steps for recover my hard earned money from the aforesaid person by arresting him according to law.
