Sir,

On 08.11.2022 Krishna Kumar Chhetri S/o Nor Bahadur Chhetri was arrested from Nepall Busty in connection with POR no 32/DG of 2022-2023 dated 08.11.2022. Voluntary statement of the accused was recorded by Sri Jayanta Mandal, WBFS, ADFO I of Baikunthapur Division under Section 58 (8)(d) of . In that statement appeared the names of Anjan Mishra S/o Dambar Singh Mishra of Kholachand fafri, PO: Salugara, PS : Bhaktinagar, Sanduk Roy S/o Sarat Roy and Sanjib Roy of Chayanpara, Salugara, PS : Bhaktinagar:

On 18.11.2022 at about 2:00am in the morning raid was conducted on the house of Anjan Mishra at Kholachand Fafri by the joint team of Dabgram Range and Salugara Range led by Shri Jayanta Mandal, Assistant Divisional Forest Officer, Baikunthapur Division. After disclosing our identity we made a thorough search of the house and on searching we recovered a country made gun, a SBBL gun, a plastic container containing 29 nos of lead pellets used as bullets, a tortoise shell, an Alexandrian Parakeet (alive) in a cage. He was asked to produce documents in connection with the guns along with the lead pellets he kept, wild animal (parakeet), and tortoise shell for which he failed to produce any valid documents.

Above possessions of weapons of hunting and the wildlife articles and live bird clearly points to the fact that Anjan Mishra has violated the provisions of Section 9, Section 34, Section 39, Section 44, Section 49-A, 49-B of the Wild Life Protection Act, 1972 punishable under Section 51 of the same act.

Accordingly I seized the Arms; the single barreled Gun and a country made Gun and the plastic Container containing 29 nos Lead pellets, the live parakeet and few other things relevant for the purpose duly described in the said seizure list.

As possession of illegal arms and ammunition violates Indian Arms Act, 1959, appropriate prosecution needs to be initiated under the said Act after registering specific case under due section of the laws against the said person.

The above mentioned one SBBL Gun and one country made gun is being handed over to you. The accused is being forwarded to Ld Chief Judicial magistrate, Jalpaiguri today.
