In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Akhil Barman (48) s/o Lt.Dinesh Barman of Dada Bhai colony, Prakash-nagar, Ward No 43, PS-Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri along with the seized article viz (i) one Truck bearing Reg. No. WB- 71 B 2914 Damper loaded with Soil.

I, ASI Rabi Tamang of Ambari out post P.S New Jalpaiguri SMP do hereby lodge a written complaint to the effect that on 01.12.2022 at around 14:05 hrs in course of Evening mobile van duty vide MCC no 2722/22 dated 01.12.2022, I received a source information that a truck having Registration No. WB- 71 B 2914 was illegally loading the Soil from Bank of Sahu River, Near Jaldumur, Dangapara fraudulently. Accordingly, I informed O/C Ambari Falakata out post and as per his direction I, along with C/505 Tapash Datta and C/1180 Susen roy had been to Bank of Sahu river, Jaldumur, Dangapara to verify the veracity of information. On reaching at Bank of Sahu rivar, Jaldumur, Dangapara under Ambari out post P.S New Jalpaiguri, we found that trucks (Damper) Loading the sand/soil from Bank of Sahu river, Jaldumur, Dangapara illegally at around 14:25 hrs the said truck having Registration No WB- 71 B 2914 to apprehend the truck and on checking, found huge quantities of soil loaded in the carrier of the truck. On demand, the driver failed to produce the documents relating to the vehicle and also failed to produce the valid documents relating to the loaded soil. On further grilling, it could be learnt that the truck driver had procured the sand fraudulently somewhere from Sahu river, Jaldumur, Dangapara under Ambari Falakata out post and taking the same for disposal to somewhere else for his wrongful gain.

As the sand come under mines and minerals substance, hence the above noted accused person of the truck have violated the norms of Mines and Minerals Act. Therefore, I seized the said truck in presence independent witnesses under proper seizure list and also arrested the driver of the truck namely Akhil Barman(48) s/o Lt.Dinesh Barman of Dada Bhai coloney, Prakash nagar, Ward No 43, Ps Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri under proper Memo of Arrest. The whole process of search and seizure took place in between 14:35 hrs to 14:45 hrs.

Under above circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against the above mentioned accused person under proper sections of law and to arrange for its investigation.
