1. That I along with my family members being owner of the below schedule land had filed the suit for partition, declaration, injunction and consequential reliefs along with an application under Order XXXIX, Rule 1 & 2, read with section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure against the defendants/respondent being Title Suit No. 257 of 2022, before the Court of the Ld. Civil Judge, Senior Division, at Jalpaiguri.
2. That the Ld. Court took up hearing of an application under Order XXXIX, Rule 1 & 2, read with section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure was pleased to pass an ad interim order of injunction being order No. 02 dated 21.11.2022.
3. That a partition suit being T.S. 257 of 2022 is pending in the Court and an injunction order in form of Status quo has been granted for the land under R.S. Plot No. 249 corresponding to L.R.
