Sub: Information about theft taken place at our shop M/s IVA MEDISALES.

Sir,

I, Sri Keshab Agarwal, Son of Late Ram Kumar Agarwal, resident of Ganesh Ram Compound, Church Road, Siliguri, District Darjeeling, Pin- 734001, West Bengal, being one of the partner of M/s Iva Medisales, situated at Bishnu Jyoti Complex, Hill Cart Road, Siliguri, District- Darjeeling, West Bengal, Pin-734001, would like to bring to your notice that we deal in wholesale medicine.

One of Our staff namely Ashish Thapa, resident of Utpal Nagar, Near Anchal 2nd Bridge, Champasaree, engaged into conspiracy with some Sri Chandan Prasad Thapa, resident of Ranidanga, Darjeeling, West Bengal, has stolen about 10 cases of medicine from our shop worth Rs. 15 Lakhs (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs) approximately. This is a tentative figure of loss that we have derived and the final figure of loss we could only identify after we complete our stock verification that we are currently going through.

On 7th December, 2022, after being noticed shortage in stock and on enquiring with all our staffs about the same Sri Ashish Thapa went absconding from that very moment from his duty. On giving him a call on his wife's cell phone for asking the reason for his absence from duty he confessed his act of having stolen medicines from the shop with the help of some Sri Chandan Prasad Thapa. Since the day he accepted his fault we have been receiving calls from various different numbers three of them are mentioned below herein 1) 7811920287, 2) 6297597962, 3)

9093398384 stating that we forgive him for his mistake and that he would repay us all our loss by working for us and deducting it through the mode of his salary.

We are at a massive loss and thus pray you to take necessary steps to help us recover the loss. Looking forward for your cooperation.


