Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complaint against Sri Rajay Roy, (Ph- 8101513932), Son of Lt Ratan Roy, resident of Sarat Chandra Pally, Behind Masjid, P.O Hyderpara, Dist- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal 734006, P.S Bhaktinagar, West Bengal. While on a routine inspection on the site having consumer id 412133843, meter no A1000220173165, having power connection by WBSEDCL in the name of Lt Sri. Ratan Roy in the address being of Sarat Chandra Pally, Behind Masjid, P.O Hyderpara, Dist- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal 734006, P.S Bhaktinagar, West Bengal, I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Sri Jotiska Sengupta, Sr O.E, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL and other technical staffs observed that the terminal seal of the meter was broken and energy was being used bypassing the energy meter via direct hooking from service cable.

We entered the premises at 1716 hrs on 12.12.2022 after handing over Notice to Sri Rajay Roy S/O Lt Sri Ratan Roy. Then it was observed that the power was being used in an unauthorized manner via directly bypassing the energy meter and breaking the terminal seal of the energy meter via direct tapping from the service cable. Therefore committing a crime for theft of power as per section 135 (1) (b) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007. The consumer has a contractual Load of 1.18 Kva. Accordingly the connection was disconnected and the energy meter and service cable were seized and labelled. A copy of both inspection report and Seizure list (1. CMS Computers LTD, 1 Phase, (240 Volts), (5-30) amps, SI No A1000220173165, property of WBSEDCL, & 2. Service Cable of Black Color, 10 Sq mm, Single Stranded, Double Core Aluminium wire of 10 meters approx) were handed over to Sri Rajay Roy. We exited the premises on 1730hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Sri. Rajay Roy under Section 135 (1) (b) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007 of India.
