Bagdogra, District- Darjeeling in the state of West Bengal would like to inform you that one of my friend **PANKAJ PRASAD**, son of Late Hari Lal Prasad, resident of Upper Bagdogra near Bus Stand, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, District- Darjeeling in the state of West Bengal, had taken Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakhs Only) on 25/08/2021 from me as loan by saying that his mother is not well and also to start his business and promised me to return the same within December 2021 but after the said period when I approached him he told me that he is having some issues and will return the same next month and every time he use to give excuses for not returning the money. On 08/08/2022 when I went to his shop and asked for my money then we had a heated argument. He insulted and threatened me and told me that he is not going to return me the money no matter what and also he is not afraid of anybody not even the Police. Since then it has been more than a year and I have been forced to take this action.

So therefore I request you to look into the matter and kindly take necessary legal action please.
