Subject: F.I.R.

Sir,

I, S.I. Abhishek Theengh S/O Suchandra Kumar Theengh posted at Pradhan Nagar P.S., Siliguri P.C. do hereby lodge this complaint against one Raj Pandey, S/O. Sri Satyendra Prasad Panday of Uma Charan Bose Lane, Kharmanchak, Dist. – Bhagalpur, Bihar to the effect that, Pradhan Nagar P.S. Case No. 957/2022 Dt. 18.11.2022 u/s 406/417/420/506 IPC was registered against said Raj Panday on the complaint of one Vishal Sharma, S/O. Soban Prasad Sharma of Narmada Bagan, Champasari, P.S. – Pradhan Nagar, Dist. – Darjeeling in which it has been alleged that said Raj Panday got introduced with the complainant in the year 2021. At that time said Raj Panday has represented himself as a Senior Deputy Collector(BAS) posted at Patna, Bihar. Said Raj Panday convinced the complainant that he have high profile influential communication and that he would help the complaint in obtaining a F.L. Shop license in lieu of Rs. 7,50,000/-. Accordingly, the complainant had paid the demanded amount to said Raj Panday but as assured he did not get the F.L. Shop License. When the Complainant demanded refund of his money, he was threatened by said Raj Panday by showing fire arms which he always used to carry with him. The case was endorsed to S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar of Pradhan Nagar P.S. for investigation.

During investigation of the case I.O. S.I. Rabindara Nath Sarkar had issued Notice u/s 41A of Cr.P.C. to the accused Raj Panday directing him to appear before himself by fixing particular date and time but said Raj Panday did not comply with the same. During investigation of the case it is revealed that Raj Panday is not a government official and there is no any post in his name in the Flood & Relief Department under the ministry of Disaster Management, Patna, Bihar as per corresponsence and communication made by the I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar with the officials of Bihar State Administration.

On 19.12.2022, I.O. S.I. Rabindranath Sarkar has got some specific information about presence of Raj Pandey at Siliguri. Raj Pandey was found accompanied by his security guard Nikesh Kumar Singh (29), S/O. Munnu Kumar Singh of Vill + P.O. - Pokharbhinda, P.S. - Shykhara, Dist. - Sitamarhi, Bihar and car driver Laddu Kumar Sha (32), S/O. Karu Sha of Natnagar, Manoskamna Mandir Road, P.S. - Natnagar, Dist. Bhagalpur, Bihar in a white colour TATA Seden bearing Reg. No. JH-15N-3483 with official Board of Bihar Government near Surendranath Institute at Gyan Jyoti Road under Pradhannagar PS. Accordingly, I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar along with myself, C/1413 Sujit Sarkar, CV/242 Rakesh Mangar and CV/992 Jagadish Biswas stopped the vehicle and asked them to accompany him to Detective Department office of Siliguri P.C. for further interrogation and verification. At about 20.30 hrs, said Raj Panday along with said driver and security guard arrived at Detective Department Office, Siliguri P.C. During interrogation I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar found inconsistency in his statement rising serious doubt that he was not telling the truth and that further verification of his credentials were necessary. The matter was informed to I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S. and I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S. also reached to D.D. Office, Siliguri P.C. There was every reason to believe that said Raj Panday was not revealing the truth raising strong doubt about his official status as well. Finally, said Raj Panday agreed to show his official identity proof and arms license to the I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar which he kept in his flat in Mountain View Residency situated at Dagapur, behind Gyan Jyoti College, Siliguri. Accordingly, Raj Panday being accompanied with his driver Laddu Kumar Sha and security guard Nikesh Kumar Singh took the I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar, I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S., myself and above noted force to the said flat.



On reaching the the above noted address at 00.25 hrs, Raj Panday asked us to come inside of a flat on the pretext of showing his official identity proof and arms license. Before entering inside the house, I.O. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar Summoned two available witnesses namely Amit Roy (38) S/O Lt. Kamasl Roy of Nabinjote, P.O. – Nemai, P.S. – Matigara, Dist. - Darjeeling and Dipen Singha (25), S/O. Khiren Singha of Bhubanjote, P.O. – Nemai, P.S. – Matigara, Dist. – Darjeeling aprise them the whole matter. On request they agreed to accompany us during the search process and police team have offered search of our person as per procedure. Then we entered inside the flat as led by Raj Panday along with witnesses.

As we are waiting in the dining room for the accused to produce and show his documents, the accused all of a sudden came armed with an automatic pistol and threatened us that he would open fire to evade his arrest in connection with above noted case. He was told to surrender his pistol and cooperate with the investigation. Without paying any heed to the words, Raj Panday become more and more agitated and desperate. It was becoming evident that he would open fire from his pistol at any point of time and make his escape. There was a serious threat to the lives of the police personals present in the room. We tried to convince the Raj Panday to lay down his pistol but Raj Panday opened one round fire aiming us and then opened another round fire consequetively aiming S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar which caused injury in his right leg near ankle seriously injuring him on the spot with furious bleeding from his wounds. Finding no other option the officers and men present there cought hold of Raj Panday in order to take away his pistol. This leads to a scuffle between Raj Panday and the police. Rational and restricted force was applied to disarm Raj Pandey in the exercise of Right to private defence to protect the live of police personnel and witnesses present there. Raj Panday strongly resisted the police and was not willing to surrender his pistol. In the mean time during scuffling, Raj Panday fired one more round from his pistol but he had mistakenly shot himself and suffured gun shot injury on his left thigh. officers and men of police force present there finally succeeded in disarming him and took custody of the autometic pistol loaded with two rounds of live cartridge in the magazine.

I/C Pradhan Nagar P.S. and some forces immediately shifted injured Raj Panday and S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar to the nearest at Neotia Getwel Nursing Home for treatment where Raj Panday refused the attending doctor for his treatment where he refused to get the treatment and have not given his medico legal consent for his treatment. Family members of the accused have also been informed about the incident. S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar is under treatment in CICU at that Nursing Home in a very serious condtion due to excessive bleeding of gun shot injury caused by the accused. Accordingly, I seized the automatic fire arms used by the accused Raj Panday, empty cartridge, bullet head etc. from the place occurance and protected the P.O. in presence of available witnesses.

The accused Raj Panday had willfully obstructed the police to discharge their lawful duty and had opened fire at the police by his automatic pistol with an intention to kill S.I. Rabindra Nath Sarkar and other police officials present at the spot to disrupt investigation and evade subsequent lawful action and arrest in the case.

I therefore pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against the accused Raj Panday under proper sections of law and arrange for its investigation.
