Sir,

I, Shyama Prasad Chakladar, Range Officer, Dabgram Range would like draw your attention to the following.

On 04.01.2023 at about 1:30am in the morning acting on a secret tip that a country made gun which has been used for the purpose of hunting, from a reliable source, a raid was conducted on the house of Krishna Das S/o Basinath Das of Velkipara, Farabari, Sahudangihat, PS : NJP at about 1:30am by a team of Dabgram Range consisting of Shyama Prasad Chakladar, Range Officer, Jahrul Md Ali, Beat Officer, Uttam Majunder, Beat Officer, , Promila Roy, Aranya Sathi, Arit Dey, DRW, Sarafat Karim, Bana sahayak and other staff. After disclosing our identity we made a thorough search of the house and after short interrogation Krishna Das revealed that the gun is hidden in the house of Prabhananda Roy S/o Prafulla Roy of village Velkipara, PO: Sahudangihat, PS : NJP, District : Jalpaiguri. Without delay raid was conducted on the house of Prabhananda Roy at about 2:10 am. After disclosing our identity we made a thorough search of the house and a country made single barreled gun and a piece of antler (deer horn) was recovered from the cow shed attached to the house. On asking they failed to produce any valid documents against the gun and the wildlife article so recovered . On further interrogation they revealed that they have procured the gun from Sanduk Roy S/o Sarat Roy of Chayan Para, PO: Salugara, PS Bhaktinagar arrest warrant against whom has already been issued by the learned CJM, Jalpaiguri on 08.12.2022. They further revealed that a spotted deer was hunted with this gun and they have supplied the antler after cutting into pieces to specific sizes to Sanduk Roy who alleged supply it to Bangladesh to be used for the purpose special charm and totka or talisman.

Above possessions of weapon of hunting and the wildlife article has violated the provisions of Section 9, Section 34, Section 39, Section 44, Section 49-A, 49-B of the Wild Life Protection Act, 1972 punishable under Section 51 of the same act.

Hence I seized all the articles along with the wild animal mentioned in the seizure list under section 50 of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 and prepared seizure list, label on the spot. As no independent witness was available at the spot at the time of seizure, so I requested my staff to be a witness of seizure and they agreed and put their signature on the seizure list. Thereafter I arrested the accused persons under Section 50 of Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. Thereafter the accused persons along with all seized articles were brought to the Range Office.
