Subject : Reminding F.I.R

Respected Sir,

I, Jhantu Mandal, aged about 36 years, S/o. Late Sri Haripada Mandal, resident of Samar Nagar, Champasari, Ward No. 46, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling, Pin - 734003, would like to draw your kind attention on the matter that on 24/11/2022 (Thursday) at around 9.30 pm at Night my pregnant wife was admitted to Siliguri, District Hospital for her scheduled delivery. My wife was admitted under doctor P. Sardar @ Dr. Pratibha Sardar. We pleaded for Section -C/Surgery for the delivery, but the doctor from the very first moment was suggesting for normal delivery. In the meantime my wife's condition was getting worst due to the have pain but the lady Doctor P. Sardar @ Dr. Pratibha Sardar was still stuck to her opinion of normal delivery. That night passed with the terrible pain of my wife. In the very next morning we saw my wife was crying due to pain. On seeing that I myself with my family members pleaded to the hospital staff for immediate Section -C/Surgery. Upon several calling in that situation Dr. Pratibha Sardar did not picked up her phone for once. After seeing my wife's pathetic condition then on duty staff of the Hospital contacted another on duty Doctor named Dr. M. Ghosh. After seeing the condition, Dr. M. Ghosh during Section - C/Surgery informed us that it is already late for Section -C/Surgery and the baby in the mother's womb has elongated and all the excreta from the mother's belly already entered in the baby's body through his mouth and nose. Dr. M. Ghosh informed that the baby is in a very bad condition and there is hardly 20-30% chance for the survival of the baby. Dr. M. ghosh said that if the Section -C/Surgery could had been done on time before, the baby would have been healthy and not deformed. On 28/11/2022, after admitted in I.C.U. (S.N.C.U.), at around 3.30 a.m. sadly my new born baby breathed his last. I and wife are shattered in grief regarding the demise of our new born baby. My wife is in a very bad conditions both mentally and physically.

Dr. P. Sardar @ Dr. Pratibha Sardar's intentional irresponsible behavior and negligence attitude is totally responsible for this tragedy. My baby could have been alive playing in his mother's lap, if Dr. P. Sardar would have been little responsible. I and my wife lost our most valuable asset, i.e. our baby only due to the negligence and irresponsibleness behavior of Dr. Pratibha Sardar.

Therefore, it is my humble pray to you to look into this matter and kindly take appropriate action on this matter under the purview of law.


