Sir,

I, Mrs. Mithu Samanta, wife of Late Partha Samanta, Residence of Santi-Nagar, Baubazar, Post Office Ghogomali, Police Station:

Bhaktinagar, District: Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, Pin No.:734006, do hereby lodged this written complain in the following way:-

1. That on 27/01/2022 my father-in-law, named by Nabo Gopal Samanta died, leaving behind the following persons are legal heirs and successors who are (a) Smt. Protima Samanta (Widow), (b) Sri. Tirtha Samanta (Son), (c) Smt. Swati Dutta (Samanta) (Daughter), (d) Smt. Dola Ghosh (Samanta) (Daughter), (e) Smt. Shipra Pal (Samanta) (Daughter), (f) Master Sumit Samanta (Grandson) & (g) Smt. Mithu Samanta (Daughter-In - Law).

2. That it is pertinent to mention here that my husband, named by Partha Samanta died intestate on 29/01/2019, leaving behind his widow i.e. myself and my son, named by Sumit Samanta as his legal heirs & successors.

3. That in the first week of May' 2022 one advocate, named by Mr. Biplab Das, Siliguri Court handed over me and other legal heirs of my father-in-law (now deceased) one photocopy of WILL of my deceased father-in-law. And as per the version of said advocate that entire property of my father-in-law (now deceased) would be distributed between his son i.e. my brother-in-law, named by Tirtha Samanta and my son, named by Sumit Samanta with a condition they would be the owners of the property of my deceased father-in-law after the demise of my mother-in-law, named by Smt. Protima Samanta.

4. That after obtaining the said alleged WILL, all my sister-in-laws, raised objection regarding the signature of my deceased father in law, named by Nabo Gopal Samanta. Naturally I contacted with one handwriting expert, named by Pradeep Banerjee, Kolkata and the said handwriting expert advised me to send all the relevant documents in connection with the signature of my deceased father-in-law and after that I sent all the necessary documents to him. After elapse of time, the said Pradeep Banerjee sent to my advocate his opinion and in the said opinion, the said Pradeep Banerjee opined "I have performed through forensic verification of the questioned signatures with admitted signatures delivered to me. After detail verification I came to a conclusion that in both the questioned signatures and admitted signatures is not executed by same persons". So the original signature of my deceased father-in-law and the signature which has been mentioned in the said alleged WILL are not the same and that created

a great-doubt in my mind & I informed the matter to my sister-in-laws as well as to the local councilor.

In such circumstances, I state that the said (1) Tirtha Samanta, (2) Mitali Samanta and also others herein above to this complaint, have conjointly, dishonestly, fraudulently have placed such purported documents for their illegal gain, depriving the other legal heirs & successors of my deceased father-in-law.

Being a helpless lady, I am praying before you to investigate the matter and take appropriate legal action against those miscreants who have committed this type of heinous crime.
