I would like to inform that I and my husband are senior citizen and the peace of our family extinguished after 15 years of the marriage of my son namely Anand Kande with Shilpa Kande, who is my daughter-in-law. Now, it's been 15 months there are frequent disputes and quarrels between them. My daughter-in-law does not prepare food for us nor she fulfills any of her responsibilities. With all of these she uses abusive language towards us, also yells at us on top of her voice, we even suffer her humiliation all day long. With that on and off she even asks us to vacate our house and ~~also~~ threatens us for committing suicide. She has no pity for our age or our health condition and treats us like a burden at our own house. Her behavior is seriously affecting our health and it's deteriorating daily because of the tortures and disputes them, we are just not able to reside peacefully at our own house.

She is extremely rantankeros lady,
I am suffering from high blood pressure also I am

a heart patient and my husband is also a heart patient, he is also suffering from prostate problem he is completely on bed rest, so its very difficult for us to suffer so much, it is our paramount importance that I and my husband live peacefully in our own house because my husband is seriously ill.

I and my husband have suffered neglect at the hands of my son and daughter-in-law and I and my husband do not feel safe in our own house.

Therefore, I fervently request you to direct my son and daughter-in-law to leave my house so that I and my husband can live peacefully, even if they don't leave unforunately and unwillingly we have to leave our place at this age, if it certainly very difficult and unfortunate for us.
