I, Smt. Manisha Rajak, aged about 26 years, wife of Bikey Gupta, daughter of Bhulu Rajak, Shibaji Bazar Road, Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling, West Bengal, PIN- 73005, was presently residing at Indapur Baramati Road, Gokhali, P.S.- Indapur, Dist.- Pune, PIN- 413106, beg to inform you that on 19/01/2018, I got married to one Bikey Gupta, son of Sri Motilal Prasad, permanent resident of Neheru Road, Siliguri Bazar, P.S.- Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling, according to Hindu rites and rituals and the same marriage was registered on 05/02/2018 before the Ex-Official Hindu Marriage Registrar. After my marriage I went to my "sasural" along with my husband at his permanent address, to live our conjugal life. But just after a few days my father-in-law named Motilal Prasad and mother-in-law named Phul Mati Devi and my husband started ill-treating me asking for dowry from my father. On refusal they started mental and physical torture upon me. On 17/04/2018, with the indulgence of his parents, my husband brutally inflicted physical torture upon me in such a way that I had to visit the Siliguri district Hospital, West Bengal. It is very pertinent to mention here that before our marriage I lodged a complaint against my husband before the Women Police Station, Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling, West Bengal, dated 18/11/2017, vide P.S. Case No. 302/2017 under sections 376/73/417 and 506 of Indian Penal Code. When the said case was under proceeding before the Court of Law, my husband and his parents approached my parents to settle the matter and on that basis and I withdrew the said complaint and the our marriage was solemnized on their request. When I got pregnant out of the said wedlock, without any reasonable ground, my husband along with his father and mother started physical torture upon me mercilessly and stopped providing me enough food and minimum needs of my livelihood. In March, 2019, they threw me out of my in-laws house keeping all my streedhan properties in their custody and made me bound to return my paternal house at my permanent residence. On

20/10/2019, I gave birth to a female baby named Rishu Gupta under care of my poor parents and my husband or his parents never bothered to visit me or even to call me or my parents for once. On 16/06/2022, after counselling made by the relatives and well-wishers of both the parties I signed a compromising declaration with my husband and the same was notarised on 17/06/2022 and my husband declared there to maintain me and my baby daughter properly and lead a peaceful married life with us without inflicting any kind of mental or physical torture upon me and on that basis in the month of September, 2022, I went to Indapur, Dist.- Pune, PIN- 413106, with my in-laws as my husband works as an Assistant Teacher in Gurukul Vidyamandir, Gokhali, Indapur, Dist.- Pune, PIN- 413106. But after going there, my husband and my in-laws increased their mental and physical torture day by day and they started to pressurise me to leave my in-law's house leaving my minor baby girl under their custody. They also threatened me that if I did not agree them, they would cut me into several pieces and my parents would never be able to trace me out. On 15/03/2023, my mother went to my in-laws house to talk to my in-laws and my husband to convince them but my mother-in-law insulted my mother with filthy languages and in front of my mother they threatened me saying that I would have to face dire consequences. I went to Indapur Rural Police Station physically to lodge a complaint on 16/03/2023, but the duty officer named Mahender Anil Pawar, refused to accept the same and advised me either to settle the matter amicably or lodge the same to the police station under my parental address.

Finding no other alternative and as I risked my life, on 17/03/2023, being bound, I left my present address along with my mother and my husband and his parents forcibly kept my baby girl of three and half years along with her birth and all other documents under their custody. I begged them for my baby daughter but they very rudely refused me and threatened saying me that if I would not leave that town immediately, they would put me behind the jail bringing false allegations against me. Being scared and helpless, I lodged an online complaint to the good office of the Superintendent of Police, Pune, Maharashtra, through my e-mail address and I left Indapur leaving my breastfed baby.

Under these circumstances, I am totally helpless having no clue as to what should I do. I cannot survive without my daughter and as I take care of her, she is not familiar to anyone else. Moreover as my husband and his parents are very cruel and neglectful in nature, I am afraid that they would not take proper care of my baby girl and may harm to her. So, considering my situation I request you kindly to take necessary and urgent steps as soon as possible as you may deem fit.
