Respected Sir,

I, SRI RAJIV KUMAR, Son of Late Ram Narayan Singh, working for the gain of Bank of India as the Branch Manager of the Iskon Mandir Road Branch having my office at Iskon Mandir Road, Siliguri, Pin: 734006, Post Office- Haider Para, District-Jalpaiguri, West Bengal do hereby draw your kind attention to the following facts that –

Bank of India is a body corporate constituted under the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertaking) Act, 1970 having its Head Office at Star House, G Block, Plot No C-5 Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra(East) Mumbai 400051 and one of the Branch Office at Iskon Mandir Road, Siliguri, Pin: 734006, Post Office- Haider Para, District-Jalpaiguri, West Bengal. I am the authorized representative of the Bank for lodging this complaint/FIR before you to inform the facts related to incidence which occurred in Iskon Mandir Road Branch of Bank of India.

- 1. That one MR. KRISHNA DAS, Son of Nittananda Das, a resident of Iskon Road, Gital Para, Ward No. 40 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, Siliguri, Post office Haiderpara, Pin: 734006, District- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal happens to maintain a current account with our branch being no. 507620110000134. The account is managed by him in the name of his sole proprietorship concern maintained under the name and style 'M/s. Krishna Bamboo Shop'.
- 2. That I inform you that a cheque bearing no. 010905 dated 26.09.2022 for an amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) was caused to have been submitted for clearance by one MR. SUMIT SIOTIA who happens to have his place of business at B-4, Shopper's point, Ground Floor, Fancy Bazar, H.B. Road, Guwahati, Pin: 781001, Kamrup Metro, Assam. The account of the beneficiary (i.e. M/s. Siotia Infratech') is maintained with State Bank of India, Fancy Bazar Traders Branch (13246), Guwahati, Assam as the cash credit account no.

39835562587. The said cheque was drawn by 'M/s. Krishna Bamboo Shop'. Mr. Krishna Das repeatedly informed our branch that a cheque will be submitted by one of his clients and he further requested the branch to clear the cheque as soon as possible.

Considering the goodwill and the transactional record maintained by the respective customer i.e. Mr. Krishna Das with our branch, the said cheque was cleared by our branch on 26.09.2022 itself and the said sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) was credited in favour of a proprietorship concern maintained under name and style 'M/s. Siotia Infratech'.

It is needless to mention here that, our customer i.e. Mr. Krishna Das, was duly informed by the system-generated text message that the said cheque bearing no. 010905 dated 26.09.2022 has been presented for clearance but for the reasons best known to Mr. Krishna Das, he kept a mum over the matter.

3. That I further inform you that all of a sudden Mr. Krishna Das woke up from his slumber only on 15.11.2022 and then he submitted one representation before our branch, informing inter alia that the said cheque bearing no. 010905 dated 26.09.2022 for an amount of Rs.7,00,000/-(Rupees Seven Lakhs only) was wrongly signed by his wife i.e. SMT. ANIMA DAS, wife of Mr. Krishna Das and further the 'M/s. Siotia Infratech' is not the intended beneficiary.

Mr. Krishna Das verbally explained that the whole confusion arose as both Mr. Krishna Das and Smt. Anima Das happens to own 2(two) separate proprietorship firms and they both maintain two separate bank accounts with our branch i.e. Bank of India, Iskon Mandir Road Branch.

However, as to how Mr. Sumit Siotia, the proprietor of M/s. Siotia Infratech got the said cheque from Mr. Krishna Das without being a beneficiary, that question was never answered by Mr. Krishna Das.

- 4. As soon as we received the information from Mr. Krishna Das, we immediately contacted the State Bank of India, Fancy Bazar Traders Branch (13246), Guwahati, Assam through email and kept on requesting them to refund the amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) to the account no. 507620110000134 maintained by Mr. Krishna Das, proprietor of M/s. Krishna Bamboo Shop.
- 5. Though we have kept no stone unturned to recover the said amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) from Mr. Sumit Siotia, the proprietor of M/s. Siotia Infratech with the help of the State Bank of India, Fancy Bazar Traders Branch (13246), Guwahati, Assam, but most unfortunately all the efforts made by our branch has gone in vein as till date the said sum has not been reversed by the State Bank of India. The said branch of the State Bank of India blatantly rejected our claim on the excuse that Mr. Sumit Siotia, the proprietor of M/s. Siotia Infratech has refused to sign the 'refund consent form' and there is not much they can do about it.
