Sir,

In Producing herewith one accused person namely Ashvin Lakra (Male/28 Years), s/o - Anastu Lakra, of - Bauriganj, PS - Bagdogra, Dist - Darjeeling under arrest and seizer list and seized articles, as noted below.

1. One Tractor along with trolley bearing Regd no. WB 41 J 2960 loaded with river bed materials (sand).

I ASI Pradip Singha of NBMC OP Under Matigara PS beg to lodge a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today 07.04.2023 morning I along with C/ 1085 Mithun Debnath & C/210 Prasanta Mardi were performing morning mobile van duty vide MCC No - 497/2023 Dated 07.04.2023. In course of my morning mobile Van duty at about 11.15 hrs I received information from my source that One Tractor bearing registration no WB 41 J 2960 along with trolley loaded with Sand is coming from Neemtala Ghat and proceeded toward Kalam Jote via Alphansa Road under Matigara PS without any Royalty or document. Accordingly I informed the matter to O/C NBMC OP over telephone and as per his direction, I along with force arrived at Alphonsa Road near Alphonsa School at 11.25 hrs to verify the veracity of information and found one tractor along with trolley loaded with sand coming from Neemtala Ghat side. Seeing the Police party the driver of that tractor tried to flee away, but we managed to intercept the Tractor along with trolley bearing Regd no. WB 41 J /2960 loaded with river bed materials (sand). On interrogation, the above noted person disclosed his name and identity as noted above. On being asked, the above noted accused person failed to produce any valid document for possessing the Sand inside the trolley of this tractor and he also stated that as per direction of owner of the tractor bearing Registration no. WB 41 J 2960 he stolen the river bed materials (Sand) from Nimtala Ghat under Matigara PS, Dist - Darjeeling. There is sufficient reason to believe that the above noted driver have stolen this Sand from river of Balason at Neemtalaghat under Matigara Ps, Dist - Darjeeling without any legal royalty/ papers as per rule, for selling clandestinely. Accordingly, I seized the said Tractor along with trolley loaded with Sand under proper seizure list and arrest the above noted person U/S 41 Cr.P.C informing him the ground of arrest after issuing Memo Of arrest. The search, seizure and arrest were made in between 11.40 hrs and 11.55 hrs on 07.04.2023.

Under this circumstance I pray a specific case against the accused person namely Ashvin Lakra (Male/28 Years), s/o - Anastu Lakra, of - Bauriganj, PS - Bagdogra, Dist - Darjeeling and owner of the tractor bearing registration no WB 41 J 2960 may kindly be started and arrange for its investigation.
