Sir,

In producing herewith seized one Vehicle bearing registration No . WB-73-F-1699 (Damper) loaded with river bed materials i.e. Sand as per proper seizure list.

In this regards I SI Pradip Kumar Sarkar of Bagdogra PS , SPC lodged a written complaint to the effect that on 10/11.04.23 night myself alongwith forces were performed night mobile duty vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 449 dt. 10.04.23 and during mobile duty at 05-15 hrs received a source information that one vehicle was seen with carrying river bed material illegally from Ghoshpukur side towards Bagdogra side. Accordingly I informed the matter to you and duty officer of Bagdogra PS and as per your kind instruction myself alongwith force left for verify the veracity of the information to Naka point near Khanna Hotel , Bhuttabari . At 05-45 we reached at Naka point near Khanna Hotel , Bhuttabari and started checking the upcoming vehicle and found that the above noted vehicle loaded with river materials was coming from Ghoshpukur side . I alongwith force tried to stop the vehicle , but the driver of the said vehicle stopped the vehicle and got down from the vehicle and flee away from there. Then I checked the vehicle and found that the said vehicle was loaded with river materials i.e. sand. I tried to find the driver and waited for the owner of the vehicle , but neither the driver nor the owner of the vehicle appears before us. It is reason to believe that the driver of the vehicle was carrying the riverbed materials by theft without any valid documents/papers illegally. During enquiry it could be ascertained that the river bed materials were loaded from Changa riverside at Bidhan nagar illegally. Thus it is suspected that the organized racket in operation for carrying riverbed materials illegally for wrongful gain and thereby causing huge revenue loss to the Government of W.B. As such I seized the vehicle having Registration No. WB-73-F-1699 loaded with river bed materials i.e. Sand as per proper seizure list in presence of witnesses. The seizure has been made in between 06-05 hrs to 06-20 hrs.

Under the above circumstances I pray that a specific case may kindly be started against the driver of the above noted seized vehicle and arrange for its investigation .
