Sub : F.I.R against abduction of Cash, intention of grievous injury and violation of right to do business,

Respected Sir,

I, Kanhaiya Kumar Gupta, son of Surendra Kumar Sah, of Siliguri hereby want to inform you that, I do business in a stall in Siliguri Regulated market bearing stall no. (G.C. 13/1). I deals in fruit (Banana) wholesale business. Today when I tried to open my shop with my labours at early morning, Uma Shankar Yadav, Raju Yadav, Shiv Narayan Yadav (Bantha), Shambhu Paswan, Binod Yadav, Lalan Mukhiya, and his friends or colleagues stopped us to do our work without any valid reason. When I asked them for this misbehave politely, Uma Shankar Yadav showed us sharp knife which he was carrying behind back of his shirt and threatened us not to open the stall or pay cut money on a daily basis Rs.2000. When I refused their offer, they took the keys of my shop forcefully and destroyed my goods (Banana) and shop furniture's, which worthy of Rs. 65,000 and took cash rupees from cash box of Rs. 50,000 which was stored in cash box for daily collection and for payment.

While Uma Shankar Yadav trying to open the cash box and I tried to stop him and his friends for doing so, Uma Shankar yadav and his friends beat me and my labours with sticks which they found beside our shop and suddenly Uma Shakar Yadav knowing that stabbing by a sharp knife may cause death, still tried to stab me thrice, however I saved myself from being hurt from the knife by dodging it.

This incident triggers the anger of Uma Shankar Yadav very much, and as he instructed his colleagues to hold my tightly, 05 to 06 of his friends grabbed me so tightly, that even after full effort I can't even move my body and Uma Shankar Yadav pulled a towel from the ground which was one of my labour's who fled from the spot in search of help, he tied my neck with the towel to stop my breathing by choking my neck. One of my labours suddenly came back and hit him by his hand on his back which pushed him and I was saved.

As this incident happened early morning no one came to rescue us except my labours, they left the shop with cash Rs. 50,000 and threatened us not to open the shop unless we pay cut money to them. We are very much scared and requesting you to take necessary step, so that in future none of us get bodily harmed which may lead to death.
