Subject : Land occupied by Tricks and giving Threats

Dear Sir,

I am an inhabitant of Village - Kawakhari under Matigara-1 Gram Panchayat Office. I bought a piece of land measuring 2 Katha 4 Chhatak from Mrs. Koushalya Roy of same village on 28 December, 2022. The land is situated at adjacent east side of our house. The East and West sides there are Brick Walls and the North and South Sides are fenced by Tin Sheets. The Door is under Lock and Key. At the time of purchasing the said land, our neighbor Mr. Ananda Barman and his wife Mrs. Mamoni Barman (Chatterjee) made intention to purchase half of the land i.e. 1 Katha 2 Chhatak and we agreed that time. They said that they will pay us on or before 15 March, 2023 at the purchased price.

At the end of December, 2022, Mr. Ananda Barman requested us to use the said land as they were to construct 1st floor roof and we agreed. But without taking keys from us they entered into the premises and started their construction related works there. We did not create any obstacles them for the sake of humanitarian ground and maintaining amicable social relationships. After closing the said construction, when we requested them on 10th March, 2023 to remove the unused construction materials from the premise and pay the amount. They told us that they would pay on 22 July, 2023 and also they shall not remove those materials any how. To solve this occupation problem, a discussion meeting was held but they were very much rigid not the remove those materials as well as occupied premise.

Again on 8 May, 2023, another discussion was held and there they gave threats to us not to enter into our purchased premise. Today on 10th May 2023 while we are Making Boundary walls on the said property, they opposed with others people.

Therefore, we request to take necessary steps in this respect.


