Respected Sir,

I, Sri Jayanta Roy, Son of Sri Rajendra Nath Roy, resident of Bidhan Pally, P.O. -Kadamtala, P.S.- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling, would like to lodge this complaint that I along with Smt. Pushpa Roy Sarkar and Sri Pradip Roy Barman are the joint owners of the land measuring 14 Decimal, recorded in L.R. Khatian Nos.- 12511, 12517 and 12503, under R.S. Plot No.- 212 corresponding to L.R. Plot No.- 512, situated at Mouza- Boromohan Singh, within Police Station- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling.

Sir, Jotin Barman and other 9 persons have been illegally trying to encroach our land and accordingly, they have broken our brick boundary wall of our land, without having any right, title and interest therein and thus, I have filed one Title Suit being Title Suit No.- 277/2022 before the Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Division) at Siliguri. After perusing our documents the Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Siliguri was pleased to pass an order, which run as follows:-

"Both the parties are directed not to change, nature and possession of the suit property as it is this day till 03.12.2022"

The said order duly communicated to all the Defendants and they have also appeared in the aforesaid case by filling their Vokatnama and they have also filed their Written Statements in the aforesaid case, signifying their intention to contest the same.

Sir, time to time, the said order of interim injunction is extended and till this day, the aforesaid order is subsisting.

Sir, knowing fully well and aware of the order passed by the Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Siliguri, on 04.11.2022, the Defendants most illegally, unlawfully, completely ultra-violating and disobeying the said order of injunction dated 04.11.2022, have constructed one Pandel upon our land, as well as on the sub-judice land and in this way, they are trying to change the nature, character and possession of the suit land for their illegal and malafide gain.

Sir, on enquiry I have also come to learn that 1) Sri Jotin Barman, 2) Smt. Baleshwari Barman, wife of Sri Jotin Barman, 3) Smt. Gangarani Sarkar, wife of Sri Manaranjan Sarkar and 4) Sri Palash Roy have illegally covered our land by constructing a big pandel thereon and they have also put some stones on the suit

land with an ill intention to capture our land by doing puja to the said big stone thereon, by ultra-violating and disobeying the spirit of the order dated 04.11.2022.

I, therefore, humbly requesting you to take an immediate drastic action against the aforesaid persons 1) Sri Jotin Barman, 2) Smt. Baleshwari Barman, 3) Smt. Gangarani Sarkar and 4) Sri Palash Roy in accordance with law, so that the order passed by the Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Siliguri on 04.11.2022 would be complied/followed by the parties to the case. Your good office and urgent co-operation is very much expected in this regard.
