Respected Madam,

With due regards, I, **SMT SANGITA GHOSH**, Wife of Sri Rupam Ghosh, Son of Sri late Rabin Ghosh Resident of Manorama Apartment, Rashbehari Sarani, Hakim Para, Siliguri , P.O. & P.S Siliguri , Dist: Darjeeling, in the state of West Bengal would like to lodge this written complain to the effect of my marriage solemnized on 02/03/1996 at Mathabhanga, West Bengal with Rupam Ghosh, Son of Sri late Rabin Ghosh, Resident of Manorama Apartment, Rashbehari Sarani, Hakim Para, Siliguri , P.O. & P.S Siliguri , Dist: Darjeeling, in the state of West Bengal. Just after marriage there was a sudden change in his behaviour and attitude towards me. He started neglecting me and refused to take care of me so much so that he started picking up quarrels on any tripling issues. Out of the said wedlock three children was born, namely Purnarathi Ghosh (25 years), Meghali Ghosh (20 years) Rishiraj Ghosh (12 years). He was extremely unhappy with the birth of two female children. He started misbehaving with me and started to maintain distance from me, he preferred staying major portion of his time outside the house and kept avoiding any kind of communication with me. He is a habitual drinker and also has multiple illicit relationships with various females. Also, he would often torture me physically by slapping, pushing and kicking me. He used extremely filthy, abusive and slang languages towards me and my daughters.

Other than expenses on food, he also stopped paying for our basic expenses which was required by me and my two daughters right from their birth. Hence the full responsibility to take of my daughters fell upon me alone. He always blamed me for giving birth to a girl child. All my efforts to come to a mutual understanding and live a better marital wife as a healthy family were refused by him. He never paid any heed to me and my daughters and continued torturing me mentally and physically. He also stopped financially maintaining us completely.

That on 01.05.2023 when my younger daughter Meghali Ghosh came back home at about 10 p.m. after her gym class, my husband Rupam Ghosh

locked the door from inside and refused her entry inside the house by using all sorts of filthy language against his own daughter when I protested, he slapped me hard and pushed me. He used extremely filthy, abusive and slang languages towards me and my daughters.

Fed up with his abnormal lifestyle and endless torture towards my daughters and me previously I lodged a written complaint against my Husband Sri Rupam Ghosh being Ref no. **Siliguri (women) P.S Case No. - 120/2019** and its still pending before Ld. ACJM Siliguri.

Even after lodging the written complaint too he continuously threatens me of dire consequences also stopped providing any kind of maintenance to me and my daughters. Madam I am a victim of prolonged Domestic Violence caused by my husband and I along with my daughters are passing our days in extreme fear and anxiety.

Therefore Madam, I will be highly grateful to you if you investigate into the matter and kindly please take appropriate strong legal action against my husband as per the provision of law and oblige me thereby.
