I Sri Nursing Das Agarwal S/O Late Raghunath Rai Agarwal resident of Jai Hind building, Shibaji Road, Khalpara, P.O- Siliguri Bazar, P.S- Siliguri, PIN- 734005, Dist- Darjeeling, W.B, beg to inform you that I am one of the legal heir of my father Late Raghunath Rai Agarwal and being a joint owner of Jai Hind building situated at Shibaji Road, Khalpara, ward No- 8 (S.M.C). That in compliance of the order dated 14/09/2018 passed by the Siliguri Municipal Corporation we started to demolition of the Jai Hind building. That it is mention herein that I have office premises on the ground floor where few moveable articles like iron locker (Tijori), three numbers of steel almirah and few moveable articles which are require for the office purposes are kept in my said office. There after passing the order in the year 2018 I along with my other family members were left the Jai Hind Building. That in the southern portion of my office premises a shop was running by one Pradip Agarwal proprietor of Sakhi Emporium.

That when we are demolishing the Jai Hind building I noticed that on the northern portion of the shop (Sakhi Emporium) a door was made by dismantle some portion of the said shop and my aforesaid articles are not in my office premises. And after being enquiry from the locality I came to know that since 2018, the said Pradip Agarwal along with his two sons namely Aman Agarwal and Adit Agarwal was stolen my aforesaid article with the intention for their illegal gain.

Therefore it is requested to you kindly take the appropriate legal action against the aforesaid persons and start a case for recovery of my said articles as per the law of land.
