Sub: Complaint against Bhairav Roy and Ramanath Roy, Son of Najar Singh Roy alias Gondogol Roy of Uttar Kamatpara

Sir,

I would like to draw your immediate attention to the following:

1. Today, I joined the patrolling team of Chutkiavita Beat comprising Bratati Das, Beat Officer, Meheub Alam, Banasahayak, Bipul Barman, Banasahayak, Kamal Barman, CDL at 2:30PM. In course of patrolling we caught two women red-handed while cutting young Sal trees at SMG-4 compartment of Chutkiavita Beat under Dabgram Range.
2. While the accused were being taken to Chutkiavita Beat Office, some persons (8 to 10 nos) obstructed us and two of them named Bhairav Roy and Ramanath Roy son of Najar Singh Roy alias Gondogol Roy started arguing with us using filthy language such as "mere chamra gutia dobo", "suar er baccha", "gache bendhe marbo" etc and threatened us with dire consequences.
3. They forcefully let the women (accused) escape from the spot. The woman could not be identified.

Above act constitute a grievous offence on part of Bhairav Roy and Ramanath Roy of Uttar Kamatpara by way of preventing public servant (as per Section 73 of Indian Forest Act, 1927) on duty from discharging their lawful duties.

In view of the above, I urge your goodself to take appropriate actions as deemed fit under law in vogue.
