Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Pabitra Biswas (48yrs) S/o. Lt. Khagendra Nath Biswas of Shelterbari, PO-Balaram, PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. 20(Twenty) sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Sprit each bottle containing 600 ML.
2. One Nylon Bag.

I, ASI. Jamirul Haque of Ambari Falakata Out Post under NJP PS/SPC lodged a written complainant against the above noted person to the effect that today on 25.05.2023 at 18:05hrs received a source information from Shelterbari, under Ambari Falakata OP that the above noted person has gathered huge amount of liquor illegally at his local shop for selling the same in the customer for his wrongful gain. This refers to Ambari Falakata Out Post GDE No. 869 dated 25.05.23. I informed to O/C Ambari Falakata Out Post about the information. As per his kind instruction I along with, (1) ASI. Rabi Tamang, (2) C/322 Jayanta Roy and (3) C/625 Bhaben Das all of Ambari-Falakata OP, Under NJP PS/SPC proceed to Shelterbari under Ambari-Falakata OP to work out the information. At 18:25 hrs we reached at the spot, sometimes after being identified by the source our police party held raid at the shop of the above noted person, situated at Shelterbari and recovered the above noted articles from the possession of accused person namely Pabitra Biswas (48yrs) S/o. Lt. Khagendra Nath Biswas of Shelterbari, PO-Balaram, PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri. On demand he could not produce any valid license/documents in support of said liquor. He become nervous and admitted his guilt before us and stated that he sell the same in the customer since long for his wrongful gain. Accordingly I seized the above noted articles from the possession of above noted accused person after preparing proper seizure list and took signature of the accused person in presence of witnesses namely (1) Abhijit Majumder S/o. Lt. Ashim Majumder of Mahamaya Colony, PO. Kamarvita, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri and (2) Subash Sarkar S/o. Lt. Narayan Sarkar of 09 No. Colony, PO. Kamarvita, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri. The seizure was made between 18:45 hrs to 19:05 hrs. I arrested the said person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. and issued Memo of arrest appraising the ground of arrest in presence of witnesses.

I therefore request you that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Pabitra Biswas (48yrs) S/o. Lt. Khagendra Nath Biswas of Shelterbari, PO-Balaram, PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
