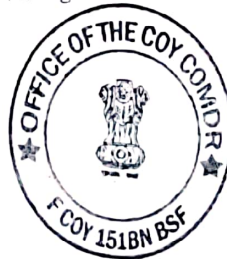

SUB- LODGING OF FIR

It is to inform you that on dated 27.05.2023 at around 1320 hrs, 02 Pers namely Mr. Bhabesh Sarkar, D.O.B – 01.01.1991, S/O Supen Barman Add- Parimal Nagar, Matigara, Darjeeling (West Bengal) Pin No. 734010 (Indian) having Aadhar card No. 966134738116 and Mr. Sukumar Roy Pachcoto, D.O.B 15.05.1987, S/O Jitendra Nath Roy, Add-Sonapota Pach Kol Tola, Ward No.02, Debiganj, Lokkirhat, - 5020 Panchagarh (Bangladesh), Passport No. A04943080 and Visa No. 7513534 came at ICP check point No.02 of ICP Fulbari (deployment- F Coy, 151 Bn BSF) from India side and asked ICP Commander to visit to Zero line. After entry in civil visitors' in/out register, ICP Comdr permitted them to visit Zero line. Both of them went empty handed. At about 1425 hrs, while returning from zero line to India side, the BSF santry saw a carry bag with 03 baby clothes and two Bangladeshi Lux soaps in their hands and checked the bag and items thoroughly. They told that their relative gave them the items including Bangladeshi currency. After the checking of bag, BD TAKa 35,000/- (Thirty five Thousand only) Bangladeshi currency were found wrapped in clothes which was received without any permission from Indian custom office /any competent authority.

Seized items and the pers from whom seizure has been done are being handed over to you.

Therefore you are requested to Lodge an FIR against the individuals with intimation to this office for our further necessary action.
