Subject: First Information Report

Dear Sir,

I, Chinky Mandal, aged about 34 years, Wife of Ratan Kumar Mandal, residing at present in Care of Baby Devi (My Mother) at Santoshi Nagar, Siliguri-734005 beg to report you that:

I was married on 28.06.2004 to Ratan Kumar Mandal, Son of Surender Mandal, Resident of Ambika Road, Santoshi Nagar, Ward No.5, Siliguri-734005 and thereafter I started to live with my husband in my matrimonial home along with my mother-in-law Geeta Mandal and sister-in-law Lakhi Mandal.

After a couple of days of my matrimonial life, my husband and my in-laws asked me to bring from my father fifty thousand rupees of dowry which my father could not give at the time of marriage. On my father's inability to fulfil their demands, my husband used to abuse me in a filthy language and on instigation of my mother-in-law and sister-in-laws namely Lakhi Mandal, Saroj Mandal and Savita Mandal respectively, my husband used to beat me and my mother-in-law, sister-in-laws, one Kapil Mandal (husband of my sister-in-law Lakhi Mandal), one Roma Mandal (Wife of Ajit Mandal) also used to join in abusing and assaulting me. Their such mental and physical cruelty and violence continued upon me even after the birth of my two sons and one daughter.

I tolerated their torture for the family prestige and in hope that one day good sense will prevail upon them but, that day never came. There were days when I had to stay without having food and my mother-in-law and my sister-in-laws also did not allow me to enter the kitchen. My husband's torture once compelled me to set myself on fire.

In the month of March 2023, my husband threw me out of my matrimonial home by forcibly restraining my children. Finding no alternative, I was compelled


to take shelter elsewhere with my mother. But, even there my husband did not spare me and repeated his torture upon me.

Yesterday, i.e., on 08th June, 2023 at about 7:00 pm, my husband threatened me that he will throw acid on my face and destroy my life forever and that he has no fear of anybody. This has left me completely traumatised and I am passing every moment in fear. My husband is desperate and dangerous in nature and can harm me under the influence of alcohol.

I, therefore, request your good self to kindly look into this matter and protect me from the danger I am facing because of my husband and his family and please take strict and prompt action against my husband and my aforesaid in-laws for the offences committed by them.
