Sub : FIR against (i) Momona W/o- Amjad and (ii) Amjad, S/o Allanu both are Bangladeshi Nationals.

Sir,

In producing here with two suspect persons namely (i) Momona W/o- Amjad (ii) Amjad S/o- Allanu of Vill-Jorun, Mirpur, P.O- Kashem Koton Mills-1346, Gajipur Sadar, Gajipur, Bangladesh, both are suspected to be Bangladeshi Nationals. That today on 24.06.2023 at about 14:45 hrs. the above noted persons were loitering in front of the main entrance gate of Immigration Check Post, Fulbari, SPC.

On enquiry it was known that both of them could neither talk nor hear. Both of them were signaling to be husband and wife, using sign language. At first, they were asking for help to go to Bangladesh, by using sign language and said Momona also showed her Bangladeshi IDs i.e. (i) National ID Card, having ID No. 3313060325256 in the name of Momona, W/o- Md. Hosen issued by Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (ii) ID Card for the persons with disabilities in the name of Momona D/o- Md. Hosen issued by Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh.

On further enquiry it was suspected that they have entered India from Bangladesh side with ill motive. Accordingly, on being search of Momona possession by on duty Lady Civic Volunteer (LCV)843 Anowara Begum the following articles has been recovered. (1) National ID Card, having ID No. 3313060325256 in the name of Momona, W/o- Md. Hosen issued by Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (2) ID Card for the persons with disabilities in the name of Momona D/o- Md. Hosen issued by Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (3) One Mobile hand set back side yellow of "Oppo"(4) One Mobile hand set of "1+ " (5) One rupa baju. (6) Two rupa payer tora (7) One rupa neckless. (8) One rupa neckless (9) Indian currency of following denomination i)500\*90=45000/- (Rs Fourty Five hundred only) ii) 200\*10==2000/- (Rs Two Thousand) iii) 100\*36==3600/- (Rs Three Thousand Six Hundred only) iv) 20\*1=20/- (Rs Twenty only) v)10\*1=10/- (Rs. Ten only). On further interrogation both of them could not produce valid Bangladeshi Passport and VISA and could not communicate as to why they are in India but Momona's husband Amjad could write and later he wrote his name and his father's name in a piece of paper.

Hence, I seized the above noted articles from Momona in presence of witnesses u/s 102 Cr. P.C. and arrested both of them u/s 41 Cr. P.C. I handed over them to O/C New Jalpaiguri P.S. under SPC for legal action as per law.
