Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Chanchal Tiwari-40yrs s/o Lt. Shri Bhawan Tiwari of Limbu busty, Prakashnagar, ward No-43 PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri along with seized articles Viz-

- (1) Ten (10) packets of Proxyco-SPAS capsules containing 10x3x8 capsules each (Total-2400 pcs), each capsule containing Dicyclomine hydrochloride IP 10 mg, Tramadol hydrochloride IP, 50mg and Acetaminophen IP 325mg.
- (2) Ten (10) packets of Winspasma Forte capsules containing 6x3x8 capsules each (Total-1440 pcs), each capsule containing Dicyclomine hydrochloride IP 10 mg, Tramadol hydrochloride IP, 50mg and Acetaminophen IP 325mg.
- (3) Twenty Five (25) packets of SAMPFX+ capsules containing 6x3x8 capsules each (Total-3600 pcs), each capsule containing Dicyclomine hydrochloride IP 10 mg, Tramadol hydrochloride IP, 50mg and Acetaminophen IP 325mg.
- (4) One Blue colour Samsung mobile phone bearing IMEI No-35374450316574/01 & 356863913196579/01 containing two sim cards (1) 7001168734 & (2) 9832013616,

I, SI, Pranim Tamang of Bhaktinagar PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge a complaint to the effect that on 01.07.23 at 19.05 hrs received reliable source information that one person namely Chanchal Tiwari has stored huge quantity of Prohibited drugs in his possession at Kamala Medical stores, Limbu busty, Prakashnagar ward No-43 under Bhaktinagar PS and was selling the same for his wrongful gain. The information was reduced in writing vide Bhaktinagar Police Station GDE no. 1506 dated 01.07.23 and informed the superiors. As per the direction of superiors about the plan of action, myself along with SI Srimanta Chatterjee, PSI Koushik Raha, ASI Dipak Karmakar, C/1430 Dilip Barman, C/915 Chandra Prakash Adhikary, C/374 Debraj Biswas after taking blank paper, wax, metal seal and knife and other investigation kits left for the PO to work out the information vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No-1507 dated 01.07.23 & MCC No.358/23 dated 01.07.23.

At 19.25 hours I along with officer and force reached at Limbu busty, Prakashnagar ward No-43 and contacted the source who showed us said "Kamala Medical stores" and the person from a certain distance. I briefed all officers and force to cordon the person as tactful as possible in order to thwart his escape from the scene. Meanwhile I called two independent witnesses namely 1) Suman Sarkar s/o Subal Sarkar of Bidya Chakra colony, Ward No-44, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri and (2) Dulal Das s/o Senturam Das of Majhabari, Ashighar, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri after apprising them about the information received and requested them in written to remain present with us during search and seizure and also called one Videographer namely Netai Chowdhury of Haiderpara, Shivarampally, ward No-40, PS - Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri with a request to record the whole process. We rounded up the store and apprehended the owner. Three (03) packed boxes were found at the store in his possession. On interrogation he disclosed his name and address as above. On interrogation about the contents of said boxes he did not disclose anything and denied having possession of illegal drugs. Then I gave him an option in writing whether he is willing to be searched in presence of an Executive Magistrate or Gazette Police Officer, on return he gave a written reply that he is willing to be searched in presence of a Magistrate. Then I informed Sri Pasang Topgay Bhutia, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Traffic East zone) SPC as Special Executive Magistrate to come at the PO as he has been detailed as SPL Magistrate and requested him to be present during search and seizure process. I also offered the apprehended person if he wanted to search the police personnel but he denied.

At 21.10 hrs Sri Pasang Topgay Bhutia, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Traffic East zone) SPC arrived at the spot. Thereafter, I opened the boxes and found illegal capsules inside. On interrogation he disclosed that said boxes belong to him which was kept in his shop styled as Kamala Medical stores. On further interrogation he disclosed that he procured the illegal capsules to deliver the same to the hill side. I asked him to produce documents if any in support of possessing such huge quantity of capsules with him but he failed to produce any documents. Hence, I seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list after properly labeling the seized articles in presence of witnesses under the supervision of Sri Pasang Topgay Bhutia, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Traffic East zone) SPC from the possession of the accused person. (Seizure and labeling was done in between on 01.07.23 in between 21.35 hrs to 22.45 hrs)

On further interrogation the accused person confessed his guilt and stated that he is doing such kind of business illegally without any valid documents/License since long for his wrongful gain. It is crystal clear that the accused person is peddling prescription drugs meant for the sick people to cater to the need of drugs abusers in the hill sides illegally which has become a menace to the life of the young generation and perishing several homes. All the seized contents are Psychotropic substances and falls under the purview of NDPS Act. Under the above circumstances it is evident that the above named accused person has committed an offence under NDPS Act. Then I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C. after issuing proper memo of arrest and informed to him the grounds of his arrest. Brought the arrested accused person along with seized articles to PS. Seizure list and seized articles were handed over to PS Malkhana Officer for keeping record in PS property register.

I therefore pray that a specific case u/s Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 may kindly be started against the accused person namely Chanchal Tiwari-40yrs s/o Lt. Shri Bhawan Tiwari of Limbu Busty, Prakashnagar, ward No-43 PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
