Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complaint against Anisha Khatun (Ph- 7679498236), W/O Md Sajjad, resident of Ashraf Nagar, opposite Ashraf Nagar Masjid, Masjid Road, Ward No 40 of SMC, P.O Sevoke Road, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, 734001 And Md Shaeed Akhtar (Ph- 9002717786), Brother of Anisha Khatun resident of Ashraf Nagar, opposite Ashraf Nagar Masjid, Masjid Road, Ward No 40 of SMC, P.O Sevoke Road, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, 734001.

While on a routine inspection at the premises of Anisha Khatun (consumer id 402716533) at Ashraf Nagar, opposite Ashraf Nagar Masjid, Masjid Road, Ward No 40 of SMC, P.O Sevoke Road, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, West Bengal, 734001. I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Md Azharuddin, Junior Engineer- II, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL and other technical staffs observed that the energy meter LG0369764 (property of WBSEDCL) installed against consumer id 402716533 was being bypassed to provide unauthorized power to charge twelve nos of Electric Vehicle (ToTo) in the premises.

We entered the premises at 1700 hrs on 10.07.2023, after handing over the notice to Md Shaeed Akhtar, brother of Anisha Khatun. Then it was observed that power from WBSEDCL circuit was being used in an unauthorized manner to charge twelve nos of Electric Vehicle (ToTo) inside the premises having consumer id 402716533, bypassing meter no LG0369764, thus no power was being recorded in the energy meter and was also not being billed. Md Shaeed Akhtar was found running an EV charging business in an un authorized manner in the premises having connection in the name of Anisha Khatun. The total physical load being used at the moment in the premises was 2KW for each EV unit, thus a total of 2 X 12 = 24 KW was found to be connected to the circuit of WBSEDCL. Accordingly the connection was disconnected and the Energy meter was seized and labelled. A copy of both inspection report and Seizure list (1. Landis & Gyr make, single phase, energy meter, Serial no. LG0369764, 5-30 amps, 240 Volts, property of WBSEDCL 2. Two core PVC 10 sqmm, Aluminium service cable of black colour of approx 10 meters) was handed over to Md Shaeed Akhtar brother of Anisha Khatun. We left the premises on 1730 Hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Anisha Khatun under Section 135 (1) (b) and Md Shaeed Akhtar under section 150 of the Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007 of India.
