my house which is registered in my name. I made
previous complaints in this regard dated 25.12.2022,
but still she has not stopped her tortures on me.

Today dated 20.07.23 at around 11:00 a.m., she
was fighting with my son Prodip Sarkar. But when I
tried to intervene she tried to choke my throat
and hit me furiously, to which I fell off in a
tin and got severe cuts on my right arm.

Hence I would request you to kindly take
appropriate legal action against her, so that she
leaves my said property as her tortures are get
unbearable day by day.

I would be highly obliged to you for your kind
cooperation.
