Subject: First Information Report Regarding a Non Fatal accident of Sri Sanju Dutta at green valley apartment, bhanunagar, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri.

Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E. & SM, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL, would like to inform you that, on 03.08.2023 at around 1.20pm we received information regarding an accident related to electrocution at Green Valley Apartment, where the victim was one of our L.T Mobile Van Staffs namely Sri Sanju Dutta, Son of L. Khoka Dutta, resident of Sarat Chandra Pally, Subhash Nagar, Opp:- Ashraf Nagar Masjid, Subhash nagar, P.S Bhaktinagar, Siliguri, Dist Jalpaiguri.

The L.T Van personnel was responding to a complaint via docket no 59722821 reported on 03.08.2023 at time 12.23 pm docketed by Sri Rajen Sharma of Green Valley Apartment, Flat D, Block 7, Upper Bhanunagar, Sevoke Road, Siliguri. They reached the spot at around 1.10pm approx and after taking proper shutdown of the 315 Kva Distribution Transformer Sri Sanju Dutta climbed the DTR structure to rectify the fault. As reported, after a while of performing the maintenance work he suddenly got electrocuted and became senseless by the power being back fed from the 50 Kva diesel generator of the apartment, which in ideal condition or under proper supervision from the part of the Green Valley Housing Society, should not have been able to come in the network of WBSEDCL. Immediately he was rescued by Sri Samir Nandi, a fellow worker and was rushed to Anandaloke Hospital, Sevoke road at around 1.30pm approx, where he is under treatment currently.

Preliminary inspection from our part indicated this incident occurred due to the negligence on the part of Green Valley Housing Society, who had operated the Diesel Generator in an improper manner. And if kept unrectified shall lead to similar or even worse incidents in future. Thus you are requested to initiate an investigation against the Electrician and Secretary & Members of the Green Valley Housing Society and any others found responsible under relevant laws of the land during investigation.

This is for your kind information and further necessary action please, by treating this letter as F.I.R.
