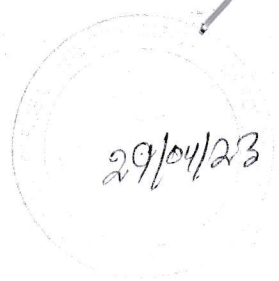

I BAGDUA TOPPO, S/o Lt. Mangra Toppo, residence of Nunujote, P.O. Chowpukuria, P.S. Bagdogra, Dist: Darjeeling, Pin: 734014, in the state of West Bengal, would like to state as follows:

1) That the said Ashru Toppo, the resident of Nunujote, P.O. Chowpukuria, P.S. Bagdogra, Dist.: Darjeeling, Pin: 734014, in the state of West Bengal who used to work as a daily wage worker and used to look after the cattle at the residence of my uncle Lt. Budhu Toppo who demised on 08.11.1996 and my aunt Lt. Titri Toppo who demised on 20.04.2011, and who now claims to be their son. Lt. Budhu Toppo at the time of demise had no children of their own and left behind me along with my other family members as their only natural and legal heir.

2) That on 09.03.2023 Ashru Toppo filed an application for rectification of Khaitan at the BL&LRO, Phansidewa, and put forward his claim of being the son and only natural and legal heir of Lt. Budhu Toppo.

3) That in the application for rectification of Khaitan the said Ashru Toppo claimed to be the only natural and legal heir of Lt. Budhu Toppo who was sole, khas land measuring 8.74 Acres recorded owner under the L.R. Khatian No.: 24, situated in Mouza: Singhijhora, recorded in L.R. Plot No.: 10,24,25,26,63,79,80,85,86 and 140 under the Block: Phansidewa, Dist: Darjeeling, more descriptively mentioned in Schedule-A below and a Misc. Case under Section 50 of the WBLR Act, 1955 was initiated regarding the claim and hearings were conducted accordingly.

4) That in the second hearing dated: 14.09.2022 Mr. Kastu Oraon, Son of Madhu Oraon who was present in the hearing claimed, that Ashru Oraon was his younger brother and was raised from childhood by Lt. Budhu Oraon and Ashru was not the biological son of Lt. Budhu Oraon and his actual and real father is Madhu Oraon and in the 3rd and final hearing of the said Misc. Case after hearing both the parties the Revenue Officer of the Case came to the conclusion that the determination of the actual legal heir of the deceased Budhu Oraon was still not clear and the 1st Party (Ashru Oraon) himself claimed that he was raised from the childhood by Lt. Budhu Oraon and he wasn't able to provide any
