In producing herewith one accused person namely (1) Rabi Pariyar (55), S/O- Late Dipak Pariyar of Chota Fapri Near Nepali School PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri and the following articles under seizure:

(1) 12 (Twelve) bottles of "HIMALAYAN GOLD 60 UP INDIA MADE LIQUOR" each bottle containing 600 ML, MRP Rs.155/- (Total- 7.2 Liters & Amount Rs 1860/-).

ISI Pradip Kr Singha of Ashighar OP PS Bhaktinagar lodged a written complaint against the accused person namely (1) Rabi Pariyar (55), S/O- Late Dipak Pariyar of Chota Fapri Near Nepali School PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri to the effect that, on 31.08.2023 - evening as per order of O/C Ashighar OP I along with ASI Munna Ahmed, ASI Sumit Baran Nath, C/973 Kushal Roy and CV/1016 Amrit Roy, all of Ashighar OP with Govt. vehicle no WB42/R 8829 were holding raid against anti-social elements, warrentees, ID liquor etc in different area under Ashighar OP as per order vide Ashighar OP GDE no. 921 Dt.31.08.2023 in course of which I received information from my source that one Rabi Pariyar stored a huge numbers of bottles of liquor inside his house at Chota Fapri, Near Nepali School and used to sell to the local youth in higher rates. I immediately informed O/C Ashighar OP and as per his kind direction wasting no time I along with my accompanied party left for Chota Fapri Near Nepali School to verify the veracity of information. On the way I called two local person namely (1) Shankar Mandal (42) S/O Late Sunil Mandal of Ashighar Colony PO Ghogomali PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri and (2) Ajay Sarkar (32) S/O Swapan Sarkar of Badar Bagan PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri to accompany us to witness the search and seizure if required. On reaching at Chota Fapri Near Nepali School area as indicated by my source I held raid at the house of Rabi Pariyar at Chota Fapri Near Nepali School. But seeing us the above noted accused person tried to flee away from the spot, but we managed to apprehend him. I searched in the house of above noted accused person, in course of which I recovered the above noted bottles of liquor from inside his house. I seized the above noted articles as alamath of the case, as the above noted person as well as none could be able to produce any documents for such illegal possession of such articles. I also arrest the above noted accused person for violating the provision of B.E Act. The Search, seizure and arrest were made in between 19.35 hrs and 20.05 hrs on 31.08.2023.

Under the above circumstances, I pray to you that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person (1) Rabi Pariyar (55), S/O- Late Dipak Pariyar of Chota Fapri Near Nepali School PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
