Dear Sir,

I, Parimal Kumar Dutta Son of Suresh Chandra Dutta residing at Block-A, Surya Sen Colony, Word no. 34 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, P.O-Siliguri Town, Police station- New Jalpaiguri, District-Jalpaiguri do hereby lodged this written Complain stating that I have filed the above noted Suit vide Title Suit no. 527 of 2023 before the Ld. Civil Judge, Junior Division Court at Jalpaiguri against Nagormol Agarwala S/O Late Mathura Das Agarwal Residing at Siliguri Town under P.O-Siliguri, P.S-Siliguri, District-Darjeeling along with an Injunction Application under Order 39 rule 1&2 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 praying for an order of Temporary Injunction and on 29.08.2023 after hearing Ld. Civil Judge, Junior Division Court at Jalpaiguri has been pleased to pass an order :- "That the Plaintiff and the defendant are directed to maintain Status Quo over the suit property and also directed not to create any third party Interest over the same as on day till 29.09.2023". That I have already informed the order of Injunction to the defendant by registered Post with A/D as per order of the Ld. Court. That knowing fully well regarding the order of Injunction, the men of defendant and the defendant's associates Amrit Vyapaar Pvt Ltd and it men forcibly trying to occupy my bellow schedule land and also obstructed my possession over the suit land by violating the order of Injunction and as such they will clearly violating the order of Injunction in recurring manner before the public at large of the locality.

That on 08.09.2023, Ld. Civil Judge, Junior Division at Jalpaiguri has been pleased to direct you, "That the Officer-in-Charge of NJP Police Station is directed to comply this order and also further directed to look into the matter for which the Court's order will not be violated in any manner causing any serious breach of peace there". Under this circumstances I Pray before you to take steps regarding the matter so that the sanctity of the Ld. Court's order should be maintained and the Injunction Order dated 29.08.2023 passed by the Ld. Civil Judge, Junior Division Court at Jalpaiguri shall not be violated by the men & agents of the defendant and their associates as mentioned above and obliged thereby.
