Sir,

In producing herewith one accused person namely Dibwas Limbu (37 years) S/O-Man Bahadur Limbu of North Tuckver Tea estate, PS+Dist-Darjeeling A/P-Amtala, Chayan Para, near Kali Mandir, Ward no-42, P.S- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with following articles under proper seizure list-

- 1] 20 (Twenty) bottles of OYE OYE 70 UP Country spirit (each bottle containing 300 ml)
- 2] 04 (Four) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml)

I, ASI Chandra Prakash Adhikari, s/o-Lt. Lal Bahadur Adhikari of Bhaktinagar Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate would like to lodge this written complaint against one namely Dibwas Limbu (37 years) to the effect that today on 23/09/23 while performing my PS mobile van duty, received a source information that one person is selling liquor in a street shop situated at Bangla Bazar under Bhaktinagar PS, without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the I/C PS and as per his kind direction myself along with officers and force- PSI Koushik Raha, ASI Dipak Karmakar, C/374 Debraj Biswas, C/1426 Prashanta Kumar Dutta had been to Bangla Bazar under Bhaktinagar PS to verify the veracity of the information. This refers to Bhaktinagar PS GDE entry no.1189,dated-23/09/2023. On reaching there and as identified by the source it found that one person was selling and storing liquor in a street shop at Bangla Bazar. Subsequently, I along with officers and force cordoned the shop and was able to detain the above noted person. Subsequently on being asked the apprehended person disclosed his name and identity as noted above. Further being searched the above noted bottles of liquor were found in his shop. On demand he failed to produce any valid license/papers for selling and storing of such bottles of liquor. On further he stated that he is involved in selling and possessing of liquor without any valid license for last 03(Three) months for his illegal gain. Then I seized the above mentioned liquor under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses. The whole process of seizure has been made in between 14.25 hrs to 15.15 hrs at the spot. As he has violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act hence I arrested the apprehended accused person namely Dibwas Limbu (37 years) S/O-Man Bahadur Limbu of North Tuckver Tea estate, PS+Dist-Darjeeling A/P-Amtala, Chayan Para, near Kali Mandir, Ward no-42, P.S- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri after observing all sorts of formalities u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraising him the ground of arrest.

I, therefore pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against Dibwas Limbu (37 years) S/O-Man Bahadur Limbu of North Tuckver Tea estate, PS+Dist-Darjeeling A/P-Amtala, Chayan Para, near Kali Mandir, Ward no-42, P.S- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and may arrange to cause its investigation for violation of rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act.
