Dear Sir,

I, **PAPPU KUMAR DAS**, son of Sri Rameshwar Das, Resident at Rishi Aribindo Road, Durga Nagar Colony, Ward No.40 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, Police Station: Bhaktinagar, District: Jalpaiguri, in the State of West Bengal, would like to inform you that on 20-09-2023 in the afternoon time in between 2.30 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. when all family members have gone outside for their respective work then some unknown miscreant person illegally entered in my house premises and took keys of the main door of the room which my family members use to keep in a secret place behind the electric meter while going outside so that other family members can take the key and enter the house. They enter into the room by opening the main door and open the almirah and took away ornaments i.e., 4(Four) pieces gold finger ring, 1(One) pair gold ear ring, 1(One) gold neck-less, 2(Two) pairs silver Anklets, total stolen ornaments value amounts to Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs) approx. and cash amount Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) by breaking the Gullak (Piggy Bank). While going out they locked the main door and took away the keys. In the evening at about 5:00 p.m. when my younger brother Prakash Kumar Das came to house he could not find the keys at the secret place and then went to knock the door and found that the door has been locked from outside. He informed all family members over Phone, on reaching home all of us search for key but could not find then we break open the door and found everything was proper in room but the almirah was open and the Gullak was in broken condition. We found the above mentioned ornaments and money stolen away from our house.

So, under the above circumstances I, therefore humbly request you to kindly enquire the matter, arrest the miscreant thief/s and also recover the stolen ornaments and cash amount from the miscreants and handover the same to me and take legal action against them as per provision of law. For this I shall always be thankful to you. Respected Sir, due to ill health of my father I was engaged in his lookafter for that there was delay in lodging the written complaint to your good office on same day but I have informed through telephonic/mobile phone on 20-09-2023 (same day) through 100 dial to police and Police Van came and did enquiry.
