Subject: Lodging a First Information Report (FIR)

Dear Sir/Madam,

I, Madhukar Pd Gupta who is the lawful and equal owner of the property situated at NJP main road, opposite Prince Lodge, Ward no. 35. Owing to personal and professional commitments, I had been absent from my room for approximately 1.5 years. On my return on 15/10/2023, in presence of the receiver appointed by the court and lawyers of each and all parties, I was dismayed to find that my relatives, namely Gita Gupta, Anuradha Gupta, Rupam Gupta, Vishakha Gupta, and Pratibha Gupta, who are family members of Shashikant Gupta, an equal owner of the property, had taken over my room and occupied it unlawfully. Not only did they seize my room without my consent, it also came to my notice that my personal belongings, which held significant sentimental and monetary value, including essential documents, jewelry, clothes, and money that were secured inside the locked room were missing. This action has not only caused me immense emotional distress but has also led to substantial financial losses, aggravated by the opposition parties denial about the same.

I hereby request the initiation of a formal investigation into this matter. The specifics of the incident are as follows:

1. Unlawful entry into room by Gita Gupta, Anuradha Gupta, Rupam Gupta, Vishakha Gupta, and Pratibha Gupta.
2. Disposal of my personal belongings and possessions without my consent.
3. The property documents and legal ownership are registered under my name too.

I kindly implore the relevant authorities to take appropriate legal measures against the individuals responsible for these actions. I also seek your assistance in retrieving or safeguarding any of my belongings that may still be recoverable.

I appreciate your immediate attention to this matter and have faith that the law will be upheld to safeguard my rights and property. I am fully committed to cooperating with the investigation and legal proceedings.
