Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely i) Md Tuhid Ali( 32 yrs) S/O Abdul Basir of Srimariya, PS Kora, Dist Katihar , Bihar ii) Md Tulmur Ali(40 yrs) S/O Md Samser Ali of Nakipur, Srimariya, PS Kora, Dist Katihar , Bihar and the following articles under seizure :-

1. One truck Dala body having registration number BR 38 D 5547 loaded with 27 (twenty seven) numbers of medium size ox brown in colour.
2. One truck Dala body having registration number BR 11 GD 3799 loaded with 27 (twenty seven) numbers of medium size ox, brown in colour.

I SI Prasan Tamang, of NJP P.S. Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this written complaint against above noted persons to the effect that on 17-18/09/2023 at 02.35 hrs while I was performing night van patrolling duty under NJP PS area, with C/998 - Sushil Ch. Das and NVF/110 - Subal Roy, other force of NJP PS, after receiving a source information, as earliest informed OC PS regarding the information, and as per his direction intercepted the above noted vehicles bearing Reg. No. BR 38 D 5547 and BR 11 GD 3799 , each vehicle loaded with 27(twenty seven) numbers of oxen huddled together at Fulbari Toll Plaza, under New Jalpaiguri PS area which was coming from Ghosh pukur side towards Assam. However, the above noted drivers failed to produce any valid documents for being possession of the cattle nor could they produce any live stock permit of the above noted oxen in the said vehicles. Even they didn't produce any valid papers in r/o of the vehicle bearing Reg. No. BR 38 D 5547 and BR 11 GD 3799 in which the oxen were loaded. It was also found that the oxen were in such manner of position causing to unnecessary pain and suffering to the cattle. On interrogation the above noted accused person made statement in presence of Police that they were carrying the cattle to Assam side through the vehicle after excessively loading the cattle. Accordingly the above noted vehicles were seized U/S 32 of the prevention of Cruelty and animal act 1960 under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. It was reasonably believed that the above noted drivers of the vehicle obtained the oxen either by stolen or fraudulent means as they could not provide any documents in support of the same nor could they indicate the source of its procurement. As such both the drivers noted above has been arrested u/s - 41 CrPC as the incident appeared to be a cognizable offence.

Under the above fact & circumstances I fervently request you to start a case under proper section of law against the above noted drivers of the vehicle bearing Reg. No. No. BR 38 D 5547 and BR 11 GD 3799 and others.
