Sir,

In producing herewith the 02 (two) arrested accused persons namely 1) Md. Jamshed (32), S/o- Mortuj Ali of Choto Sohor, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur and 2) Md. Rakib (27), S/o- Md. Joraj of Bikore, Near Rice Mill, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur along with the following seized articles under proper seizure list :-

1. One black colour Plastic Packet containing 1 (one) kg suspected to be Brown Sugar.
2. One black colour Plastic Packet containing 1 (one) kg suspected to be Brown Sugar.
3. One 14 (fourteen) wheeler TATA Truck having Registration No. NL 01 AD/ 1747
4. One white colour Mahindra Pickup van having Registration No. WB 59 C/ 5444.
5. One white colour OPPO smart phone with SIM Card No. 8101413099.
6. One black colour REDME smart phone with SIM Card No. 6002106783.

I, SI Shib Sankar Das, S/o- Nirmal Das of New Jalpaiguri Police station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint against above noted 02 (two) arrested accused persons to the effect that today on 19.10.2023 at about 19.15 hrs, I received a specific source input that one person coming from Coochbehar side in hand over to his designated customer which deal will be held at Pradip Hotel parking place under NJP PS, SPC. Accordingly, I diarized the matter vide NJP PS PS GDE No. 894, Dt. 19.10.2023 and I informed the matter to you and Khagen Barman, C/1044 Hari Kherwar, C/152 Abdul Kayum Mia all of NJP PS, SPC being headed by me left for Pradip Hotel, under New Jalpaiguri PS, Dist- Jalpaiguri by govt. vehicle with investigation kit to verify the veracity of the information in hand vide NJP PS GDE No 895, Dated- 19.10.2023 and M.C.C. No. 1687/23, Dated- 19.10.2023. I also informed the videographer namely Tapan Mandal, S/o- Tusto Mandal of Bhola More, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri to be present at Pradip Hotel, under NJP PS, Dist- Jalpaiguri to prepare the Video of whole process of search and seizure if any. Under this circumstances any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidences of facility for the escape of the offender. I also informed in writing to the Special Executive Magistrate Shri Suraj Thakuri, WBPS, ACP(EB), SPC for his presence at the spot during search and seizure if required. At about 19.45 hrs we arrived at Pradip Hotel under NJP PS, SPC and called two independent witnesses namely (i) Md. Sabir, S/o- Md. Sanibullah of Pradhan Para, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and (ii) Md. Montu, S/o- Md. Mofijuddin of Nipania, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and disclosed our identity and informed them about the information in hand and requested them to accompany us and remain present in the whole process during search and seizure if necessary with a written letter and necessary permission of their presence and act as independent witnesses under relevant provision of law. After arrival at the spot we were hidden ourselves and waiting for the target. Meanwhile Special Executive Magistrate Shri Suraj Thakuri, WBPS, ACP(EB), SPC also reached at the spot and joined with us. At about 22.35 hrs, identified by the source, we saw one truck having registration no. NL 01 AD/ 1747 coming from Jatiakali side and entered to the parking place of Pradip hotel and parked the vehicle. Within 5 (five) minutes another Mahindra Pickup van having registration no. WB 59 C/ 5444 entered into the parking place of Pradip Hotel and parked the vehicle beside the said truck and the driver of the pickup van entered into the said truck. Accordingly, we went near to the said truck and on being asked, they disclosed their identity as noted above.

After disclosing our identity, we detained the above noted persons who were inside the said truck with a strong reason to believe that they illegally possessing and dealing suspected to be Brown Sugar for their clandestine disposal the same for their wrongful gain. On being asked they confessed their guilt and admitted that the driver of the said truck named Md. Rakib possessed the suspected to be Brown Sugar from Manipur and handed over the same to the driver of pickup van named Jamshed Alam for their illegal gain. Then I gave them option in writing whether they wanted to be searched in presence of Judicial Magistrate or by any Executive Magistrate. The apprehended persons agreed to be searched by Executive Magistrate. Then I introduced to Shri Suraj Thakuri, WBPS, ACP(EB), SPC as an Executive Magistrate to them. I also offered the apprehended persons to search our Police Party as per provision of law but they denied to search police party. Then In presence of Special Executive Magistrate Shri Suraj Thakuri,

WBPS, ACP(EB), SPC and two independent public witnesses, we searched the said truck and found 2 (two) black colour plastic packet containing suspected to be Brown Sugar from the possession of the two detained persons. On demand in presence of the Special Executive Magistrate, they failed to produce any valid document in support of possessing the suspected to be Brown Sugar which they were possessing. After weighing, it was found that the plastic packets containing 1 (one) kg. suspected to be Brown Sugar in each packet. Accordingly I seized the plastic packets containing suspected to be Brown Sugar, the said 2 (two) vehicles and 2 (two) mobile phones which were found from the possession of the detained persons. Then I sealed the plastic packets in 2 (two) envelopes, labeled the same and marked as Exhibit-'A' and 'B'. The whole process of seizure was made in between 23.05 hrs to 23.35 hrs.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles it is quite evident that the accused persons namely 1) Md. Jamshed (32), S/o- Mortuj Ali of Choto Sohor, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur and 2) Md. Rakib (27), S/o- Md. Joraj of Bikore, Near Rice Mill, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur (Not verified) are involved in procuring and selling of Brown Sugar illegally and contravening the norms of NDPS Act was established. Then, I arrested the above noted accused persons u/s 41 of CrPC after observing all guidelines of Apex court of arrest as well as after disclosing the cause of arrest and issued necessary Memos of Arrest.

Under the above noted facts and circumstances, I pray to you that a specific case under proper sections of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused persons namely 1) Md. Jamshed (32), S/o- Mortuj Ali of Choto Sohor, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur and 2) Md. Rakib (27), S/o- Md. Joraj of Bikore, Near Rice Mill, PS- Karandighi, Dist- Uttar Dinajpur and others as noted above and arrange for its investigation.
