I would like to further inform you that my said aunt namely Savitri Devi Agarwal is the registered owner of land measuring about 14.75 Decimals by virtue of a registered Deed of Sale being instrument no. 6312 for the year of 2013. (Photocopy of sale deed no. 6312 of 2013 is annexed herewith as Annexure 'D')

I would like to further inform you that after purchasing the said landed property we made the boundary wall and affixed with one Iron gate and put the padlock thereon.

I would like to further inform you that one Tepua Roy @ Tepua Singh Roy was the actual recorded owner of a piece of land measuring about 7.06 Acre and being the recorded owner said Tepua Roy had transferred the said entire land to one Kahucha Singh Roy and Sukhendra Nath Roy by virtue of two separate sale deed being 383 of 1959 and 384 of 1959

I would like to further inform you that said Tepua Roy during his life time had sold and transferred his recorded landed property against the valuable consideration but his legal heirs suppressing the said material facts, they are again and again selling the said landed property to the various intending purchasers against the valuable consideration and said intending purchasers having the knowledge that said legal heirs have no right to sale and transfer said landed property but knowingly well they are purchasing the said land below the market price and after purchasing, they are trying to enter into our landed property for their ulterior motive and illegal gain.

I would like to further inform you that today in the morning said Mohan Ghosh, Bhabananda Roy & Pradip Banik along with 22 to 25 persons have removed the padlock of the main entrance and entered into our said landed property and started to dig earth with an intention to take the physical possession of the said land and on protest they misbehaved with me and threatened with dire consequences and told that they will grab the said land at any cost.

Under the above circumstances I would like to request you to investigate the matter and do needful for the ends of justice.
