Subject: Formal Complaint against Physical Assault and Verbal Abuse at Hongkong Market
Dear Sir,

I am writing to lodge a formal complaint against an incident of physical assault and verbal abuse that occurred on the 30th of October 2023 at Hongkong Market in Siliguri.

I, Smt. Amrita Gurung Chhetri, residing in Upper Gandhinagar, Ward No. 43, Siliguri, along with my son, Pukar Chhetri, and three relatives visiting from Nepal, went to Hongkong Market at approximately 2:30 PM for shopping during the Puja festival. During our visit, my son, Pukar Chhetri, expressed interest in purchasing a pair of slippers from a shop owned by Mr. Amit Hazra, a resident of Ghugumari Pipeline, Ward No. 36, Siliguri.

Upon inspecting the available slippers and expressing disinterest due to their poor quality, my son was subjected to derogatory and offensive comments by Mr. Amit Hazra, specifically body shaming remarks. This led to a heated discussion between my son and the shopkeeper, resulting in a group of individuals gathering around us and physically assaulting my son with blows, kicks, belts, and rods.

I am submitting a video evidence captured by a vlogger on the YouTube channel "Daily India Vlogs," which clearly depicts the individuals involved in the assault. At 2:18 seconds, a person in a black T-shirt is seen hitting my son with a rod. At 2:44 seconds, an individual wearing a yellow T-shirt with white stripes is visible, and at 2:48 seconds, another person in an orange T-shirt physically assaulted my son, and further outraged my modesty.

This unprovoked and brutal attack took place while we were present as customers in the market, engaging in ordinary shopping activities. Therefore, I earnestly request your immediate intervention and strict action against the individuals involved in this inhuman behavior and assault.

I seek justice and a thorough investigation to bring the perpetrators to account for their actions. Your prompt action in this matter is highly appreciated.
