

I, Madhudipa Sarkar, wife of Pradip Karmakar, residing at Rabindra Pally, Matigara, near TDSL wine shop, Dist- Darjeeling, PIN- 734010 informing you that in front of our house there is a wine shop. On 24-11-2023 at about 11:00 pm one Jayanta Basak @ Khokon, son of Ranjit Basak, residing in front of HIMUL Main gate was consuming alcohol in front of the said wine shop and parked his vehicle (WB74X 8348) by blocking the public road. At that time was I was coming from a marriage reception party and going towards my residence with my husband. My husband was driving our Hyundai Eon car. My husband politely requested Jayanta Basak @ Khokon to move the said vehicle from their and allow us to go. But said Jayanta Basak @ Khokon along with his four other friends denied to move the said vehicle and started to use filthy, voluptuous statements to me. My husband protested and said Jayanta Basak @ Khokon along with his friends started to beat my husband very badly by a stick. They also gave some fists and blows on my husband's face, chest and on lower abdomen. My husband got heavily injury on his eyes head and chest. One tooth of my husband has also broken. When my husband fall on the road said Jayanta Basak pressed my husband's throat in order to kill him. At that time I was shouting for help, somehow some local inhabitants came and seeing them said Jayanta Basak @ Khokon and his friends ran away from the spot. Those local inhabitants rescued me and my husband and we took my husband to North Bengal Medical College and Hospital. Presently my husband is under treatment in the said hospital. This is to be mentioned my husband is a patient of renal malfunction.

For the medical emergency there is a short delay in lodging this complaint.

Therefore you are requested to take the necessary action against those persons under proper section of prevalent laws.
